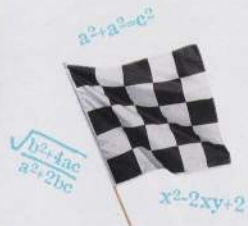

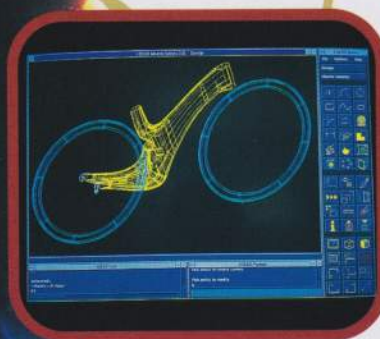

A Giant bicycle is not just a piece of technology. It's a synthesis of craftspeople and materials, riders and designers. Which is why a number of world-class athletes

regularly peer over the shoulders of Giant's designers — a dynamic partnership behind every Giant bicycle. Meet some of the key players.

No one has dominated the sport of mountain bike racing like John Tomac. And no athlete is fussier about what he rides. So John's collaboration with Daniel Shiau—one of the bicycle world's most talented designers—produces designs that are just right.

And talk about a team: Jason Richardson, the hottest rider in pro BMX, and Linn Kastan, whose BMX designs have been driving the sport since the late 1970s. Linn cranks out the designs. Jason thrashes them. Result: Giant's MOSH line, the best BMX bikes in the world.

Finally, there's Mike Burrows. The man behind the Olympic-winning Lotus bike is also the man behind Giant's new monocoque frames and Compact Road Geometry: works of carbon-fiber art, made to ride-fast.

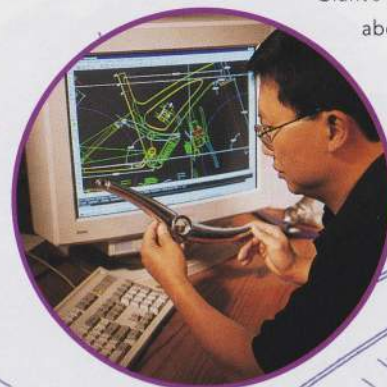

Giant's fanatic attention to quality control is why we produce our own carbon fiber. Thanks to computer-aided design (CAD) techniques, we can analyze load stress and fatigue on a frame, and then bolster our frames by adding Twaron strands to high-stress areas. Every frame is fine-tuned to serve up a virtually perfect ride.



Carbon and Twaron (the stuff of bulletproof vests) are custom-layed up in huge molds. Result: extraordinarily lightweight and strong carbon fiber frames.



Behind every Giant frame is a legacy of pioneering technology and careful craftsmanship.

We want you to know what your bike is made of. Why?

Because frame material largely dictates how a bike rides.

By the way, Giant doesn't just order up the same mass-produced tubing used by dozens of other bike manufacturers. We're intimately involved in the design and manufacture of all our frame materials. It's why a Giant is distinctly a Giant.

Take, for example, CU92 aluminum. Made for Giant by Alcoa, CU92 is 30 percent stronger than standard 6061 aluminum, so its strength-to-weight ratio is superior. Our CU92 machines have thinner walls for lighter weight, yet they're still super-stiff and responsive, never overly harsh, and have better fatigue life.

In Giant's hands, carbon fiber is the ultimate frame material. Extremely strong for its weight, carbon is lighter and stiffer than aluminum or steel. Giant is one of the few bike manufacturers that makes its own, from viscous goo and fibrous strands right on to space-age-strong frames and forks.

And for 1997, our monocoque MCM (mountain) and MCR (road) carbon frames come out of a mold immensely strong and light—the most exciting-to-ride bikes we've yet produced.

The Giant Way to Choose a Bike.



Bikes are like people: Each has a personality, and each has its strong suits and limitations. Each bike represents a unique combination of

characteristics. The symbols you see here stand for these traits and will help you gauge each model at a glance. Find the bike with the right combination for you, and it's time for a test ride.

First, consider the type of bike you want. To a great extent, this decision will determine where, how far, and how fast you can ride. Comfort is a factor here, too. Within each category there's a range of performance levels that the other symbols will help you determine.

Materials and performance go hand-in-hand. If recreation is more important to you than high performance, there's no need to spend the money on exotic frame confections. On the other hand, a bike built to perform is often more fun to ride.

As for suspension, shock-absorbing systems on a mountain bike can make it more comfortable, but suspension is really about performance: maximizing control over rough surfaces at speed.

Finally, consider the type of rider you are—and, just as important—the type of rider you want to be.



THE BIKES

MOUNTAIN SERIES

Fat tires and sturdy frames have virtually redefined the sport of bicycling—mountain bikes are extraordinarily strong and stalwart over the roughest terrain. Factor in their low gears, and suddenly you're riding up steep stuff and exploring back-country trails you'd never dreamed of riding. Even if you seldom venture off-road, you'll appreciate a mountain bike's upright stance and soft ride. When you're into expanding horizons, this is the bike you want.

ROAD SERIES

Lightweight frames, narrow tires, and drop bars make road bikes the fastest and most effortless bikes to ride. The key is the way they duck the breeze—because wind resistance is the most significant deterrent to speed on a bicycle. Getting aero means faster, less fatiguing riding. And there's a comfort bonus, too: drop bars allow you different hand positions, so your hands and arms get a break. If pavement is where you ride, you'll ride faster, longer, and happier on a road bike.

CROSS SERIES

Versatility is the key here. Also known as hybrids, cross bikes combine the comfort of a mountain bike and the easy ride of a road bike. Like mountain bikes, cross bikes have an upright, see-the-world position and wide-range gearing (easier to climb hills), but the skinnier tires and lighter frames make them less work to ride on pavement. The result is a bike ideally suited to neighborhood riding, commuting, and touring.

BMX SERIES

Born in the demanding arena of BMX racing, MOSH bikes combine the attributes of serious performance and unlimited potential for fun. The frames are designed for lightweight agility, with the strength to stand up to the earth-air-earth cycle of BMX riding. Components are chosen for light weight and durability. In other words, you can pummel these bikes. They like it.

YOUTH SERIES

Don't confuse youth bikes with toy bikes. All the expertise that Giant brings to building high-performance bikes also goes into making bikes that kids can ride hard and enjoy, day after day, year after year. Available in a number of different designs, you'll find a youth model from Giant to please any budding biker.

MATERIALS

CARBON FIBER

The ultimate frame material, Giant's carbon fiber is lighter than aluminum or steel, yet stiffer and stronger. We make our own, so quality control is superior. Because it's so stiff, carbon is perfect for a suspension mountain bike. And because it's so light, it's ideal for roadies who ride fast and far.



steel

STEEL

Using the material of choice for everyday sport and recreation bikes, steel bikes are strong, reliable, and good values. Some steel bikes contain chrome molibrium (cro-moly) alloy which increases steel's strength. This allows Giant engineers to design lighter frames when using cro-moly steel.



cro-moly

CRO-MOLY

Lighter than conventional steel, cro-moly blends strength and resilience for a great ride. Giant's cro-moly downtubes are oversized, ovalized and butted to resist lateral flex, while retaining a nimble feel.



aluminum

ALUMINUM

Aluminum is stiffer, stronger, and lighter than steel—and Giant's CU92 is 30% stronger than conventional 6061 aluminum. It's also rustproof, highly resistant to corrosion, and has a longer fatigue life.

SUSPENSION



dual suspension

DUAL SUSPENSION

For maximum off-road performance, you want shock-absorption in both the front and rear. Adding suspension to the rear means you can stay seated (and keep pedaling) even over very rough rocks and drop-offs. And they're not just for downhillers: Keeping both wheels on the ground means comfort and performance anywhere you ride.

FRONT SUSPENSION

This is shock-absorption where you need it most: a suspension fork compresses as the front wheel impacts objects. You go right over rocks and other obstacles that might otherwise stop the wheel or jar your body. Instead of a bouncy ride, your wheel stays on the ground and you stay in control—ergo, more comfort, less fatigue. You pay a bit more in terms of weight and cost—but get suspension if you do a lot of rough riding.

THE KEY FACTOR: YOU.

What kind of rider are you? Because different bikes are suited to different levels of ability and aggressiveness, we've designated all our bikes with a symbol that indicates who will get the most from the bike.



PRO

Cycling is your passion. Staying strong and getting stronger is important to you. You push your limits. If the ride isn't hilly, it's boring. On pavement, you take your pulls in a paceline and hammer out intervals on your own. In the dirt, you hone your technical skills and the term "limit of adhesion" means something to you.



EXPERT

What's fun for you is riding fast and often. On the road, you keep a brisk and steady cadence, pay attention to your mileage, and ride occasional centuries. Off the road, you look for challenges: singletrack trails, long climbs, quick descents. You can't always ride daily, but you'd like to.



SPORT

Above all else, you ride for fun—with the family, friends, by yourself. You enjoy the exercise, too, and sometimes use your bike for practical purposes: a ride to work, or down to the store. Occasionally you break away for a long weekend ride or a group event on country roads.

If it fits ride it



What a difference fit makes!
Sore necks, shoulders, and knees are easily eliminated through proper fit.

Standover clearance:

Straddle the bike just forward of the saddle and lift the top tube to your crotch. On a mountain bike, you need four to six inches of clearance; an inch or two less on a road or cross bike.



Seat height: Your knee should be slightly bent at the bottom of each pedal stroke. If your leg is fully extended, the saddle is too high. If more than slightly bent, you'll stress your knees and quads.



Reach: You want a bit of forward lean (about 45 degrees) with your arms slightly bent. Comfort is the key. Swap handlebar stems to suit your preference.
