At Bianchi, the link between our glorious history and today's hot bed of technology is captured in one unique color that is unmistakably Bianchi: Celeste. So revered is the hue-not quite green, not quite blue- that one only needs to catch a glimpse of the legendary racing color to know that it was a Bianchi that just went blazing past. Known the world over as a symbol of quality and race-proven performance for over 113 years, it represents the heart and soul of Bianchi.

Fast forward to 1998. No one needs to tell you about how much Bianchi has contributed to the world of cycling. You can look that up in the history books. What we care about is how much you'll enjoy the Bianchi you go out and buy tomorrow. That's why we've put so much knowledge and technology in all of our bikes. And no one has more experience in putting road and mountain bike racing R&D into a bike line. No matter what you spend on a new Bianchi, you're getting the cumulative efforts of world champions, bicycle innovators, and hard-core enthusiasts from all over the planet.

It's no accident that Bianchi bicycles ride as well as they do. Over 113 years of building race winning road and mountain bikes gives us more cumulative knowledge about frame building than most other bicycle companies in the world. This knowledge, along with sophisticated computer aided stress analysis and design, has led Bianchi engineers and designers to our most important frame innovation to date: MegaPro. The dilemma with bicycle frame construction is keeping the bike laterally stiff while at the same time maintaining a vertically compliant feel that won't beat you up over the course of a ride (input we've gotten indicates that this is as important on a 35 mile club ride as it is on a 275 kilometer stage of the Tour de France). MegaPro, seen throughout our entire road collection, is the answer. Differential tube shaping — pioneered by Bianchi and now an industry standard — has evolved into what we feel is a superior design for the bicycle frame. It all starts with a dramatically oversized down tube that is shaped to fight torsional forces from torque at both ends of the bicycle. This dual "ovalization" (vertical at the head tube, horizontal at the bottom bracket) enhances every aspect of a bike's performance: it's laterally stiff for instant acceleration and precise handling, yet vertically, the bike acts almost like a shock absorber to capture road shock so that you ride in comfort. By incorporating the MegaPro solution, we are able to bring out the best qualities of every tubing material we utilize, whether it be steel, titanium, or aluminum.

For the ultimate in resilience and light weight, titanium alloy can't be touched. Nowhere will you find more attention to detail than in Bianchi's custom drawn and formed titanium tubing. Yeah, it's a little more expensive than CrMo or aluminum, but in this case you're definitely getting what you pay for. In fact, when you compare Bianchi's titanium frames to other "custom" titanium frames, in addition to the superior ride qualities of titanium, you're also getting the Italian frame building craftsmanship that has made Bianchi a legend world-wide. And once again Bianchi's Reparto Corse brings you the latest in titanium technology. Starting out as a way to solve the lack of bottom bracket stiffness in titanium framesets, the TI Mega tubeset revolutionized titanium frame production. Working closely with the famed Columbus tubing company, diameters were increased and ovalization was incorporated to create a very large and stable connection in the bottom bracket area. We have taken this road race-winning body of knowledge and applied it to our mountain bikes, where we have excelled in cross country and downhill racing (World Champion 1996 and World Cup victories) with the most scientifically advanced off-road titanium frames imaginable.

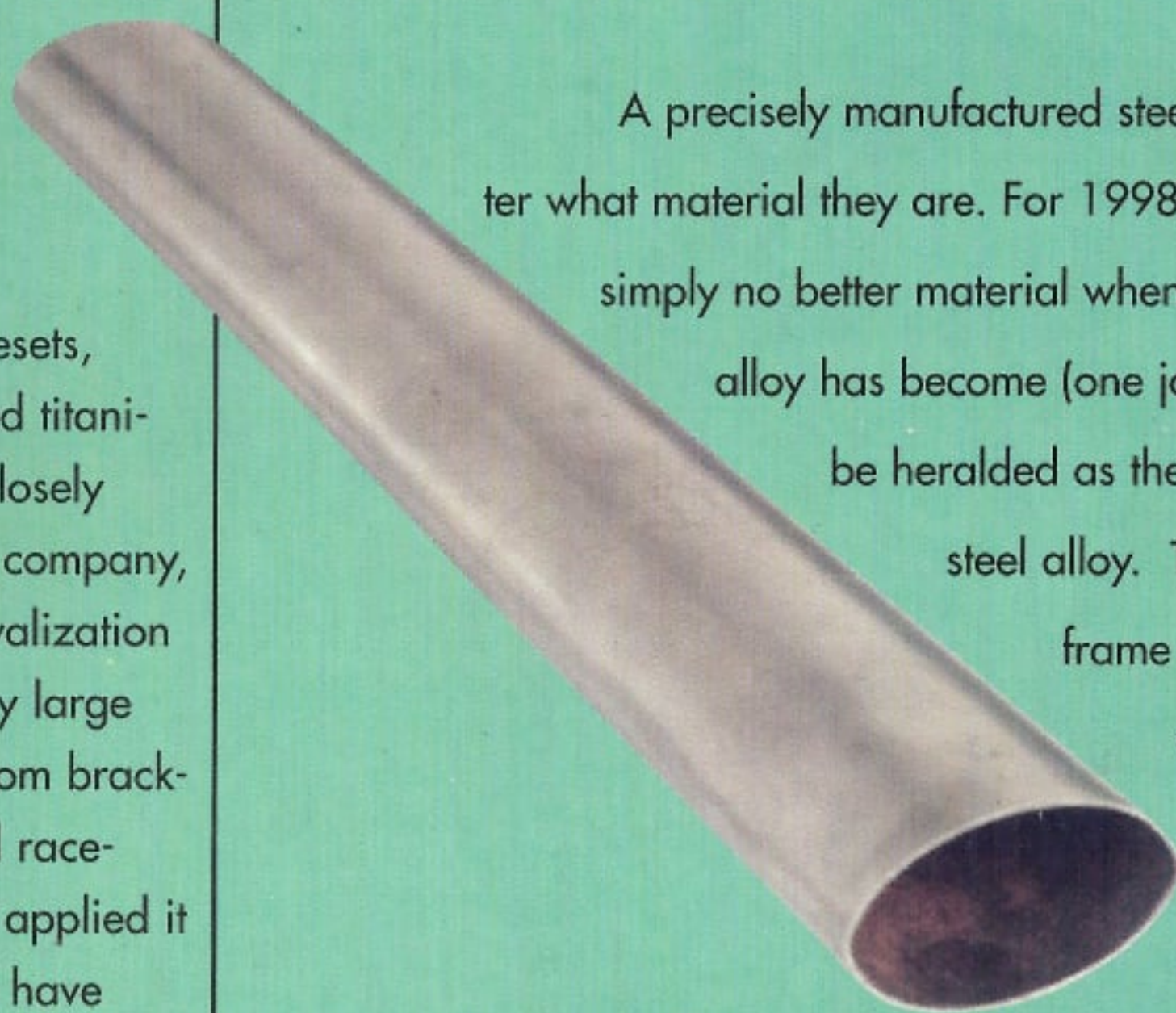
Frame Materials

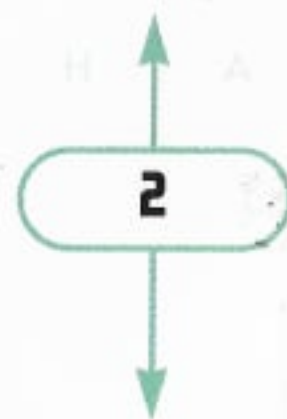
Tried and True

Bianchi engineers have an unwavering ethic when it comes to making bikes: If it ain't broke, don't fix it. We're not about to use our customers as guinea pigs. While other companies are messing around with plastics and wild designs, Bianchi makes its frames with what have proven to be the strongest, lightest, and stiffest materials. There's no guesswork when it comes to butted CrMo, aluminum, and titanium, because we've been making bikes with these materials longer than just about anyone.

THE FEEL OF STEEL

A precisely manufactured steel alloy frame is still the standard by which all frames are measured, no matter what material they are. For 1998, Bianchi offers the most diverse selection of steel alloy frames ever. There is simply no better material when it comes to cost-to-weight, and cost-to-performance. As refined as steel alloy has become (one journalist recently quipped that if steel alloy were introduced today, it would be heralded as the new wonder material), Bianchi has taken it one step further with Dedacciai steel alloy. The material, a more complex blend of metals that creates a stiffer, lighter frame than standard CrMo steel, has garnered numerous championships, including wins in the Tour de France and World Championships. The combination of resilience, lithe acceleration, and ride-all-day comfort is typified on our road racers with the MegaPro frame design and superb mix of tubes. Starting with the ultra-light Zero tubeset, all the way to our Zero/Uno framesets on our Veloce, and Zero/Tre on our Campione. And the same benefits that steel alloy holds for the road also goes for the dirt. You'll find the sweet riding Dedacciai tubing on our Grizzly, Zero Mega RC and Denali mountain bikes as well.

With the Volpe's wide range Shimano RSX gearing, cantilever brakes, and sturdy wheelset, you might not turn back when the pavement turns to dirt road and the hills start getting really steep. The Volpe is by far our most versatile road bike, with a strong TIG welded double-buttet CrMo frame, comfortable rider compartment, and stable 30C tires. This is a great entry level tourist or commuter, with all the grace and heritage of our more expensive road and sport touring bikes.
