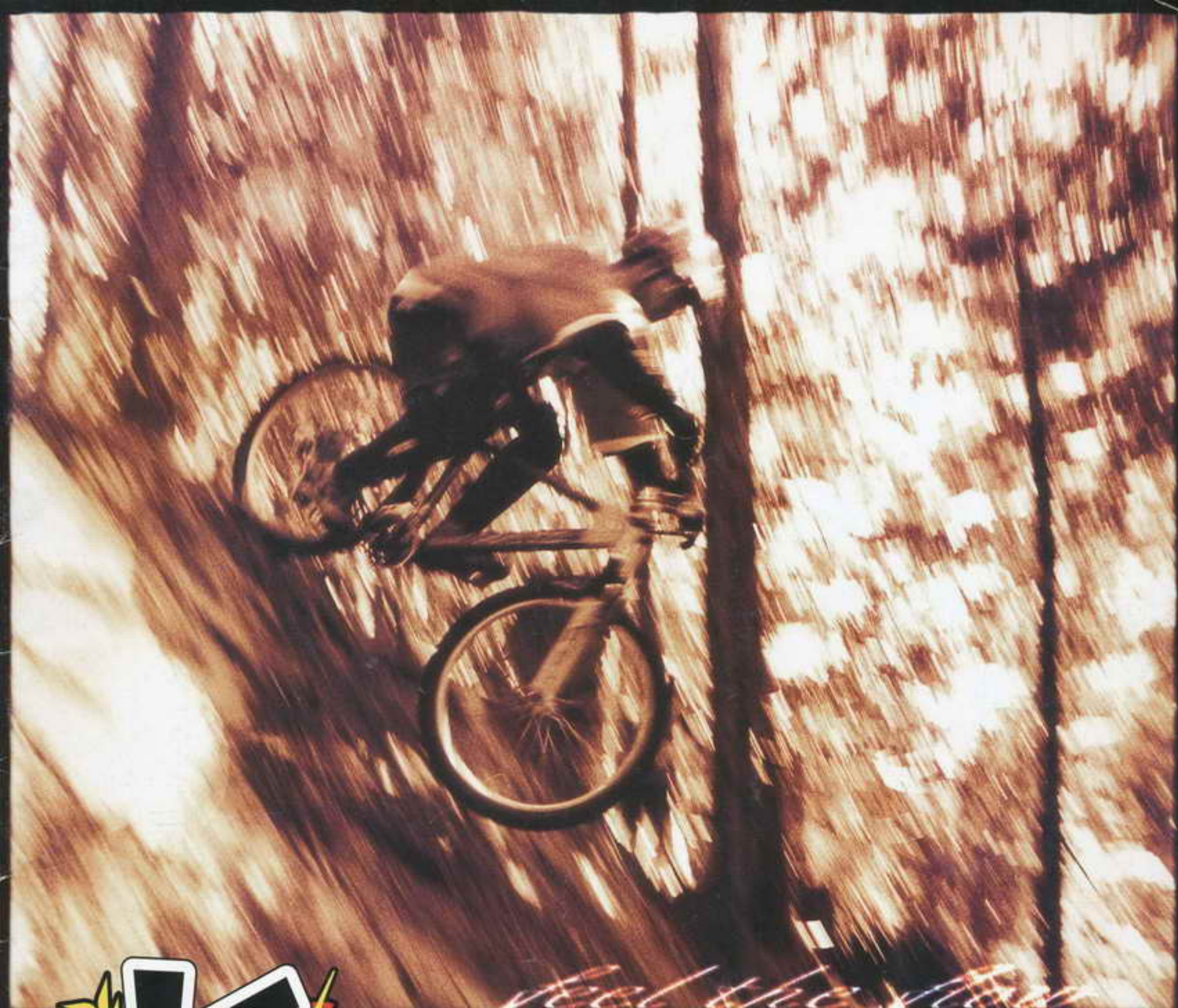
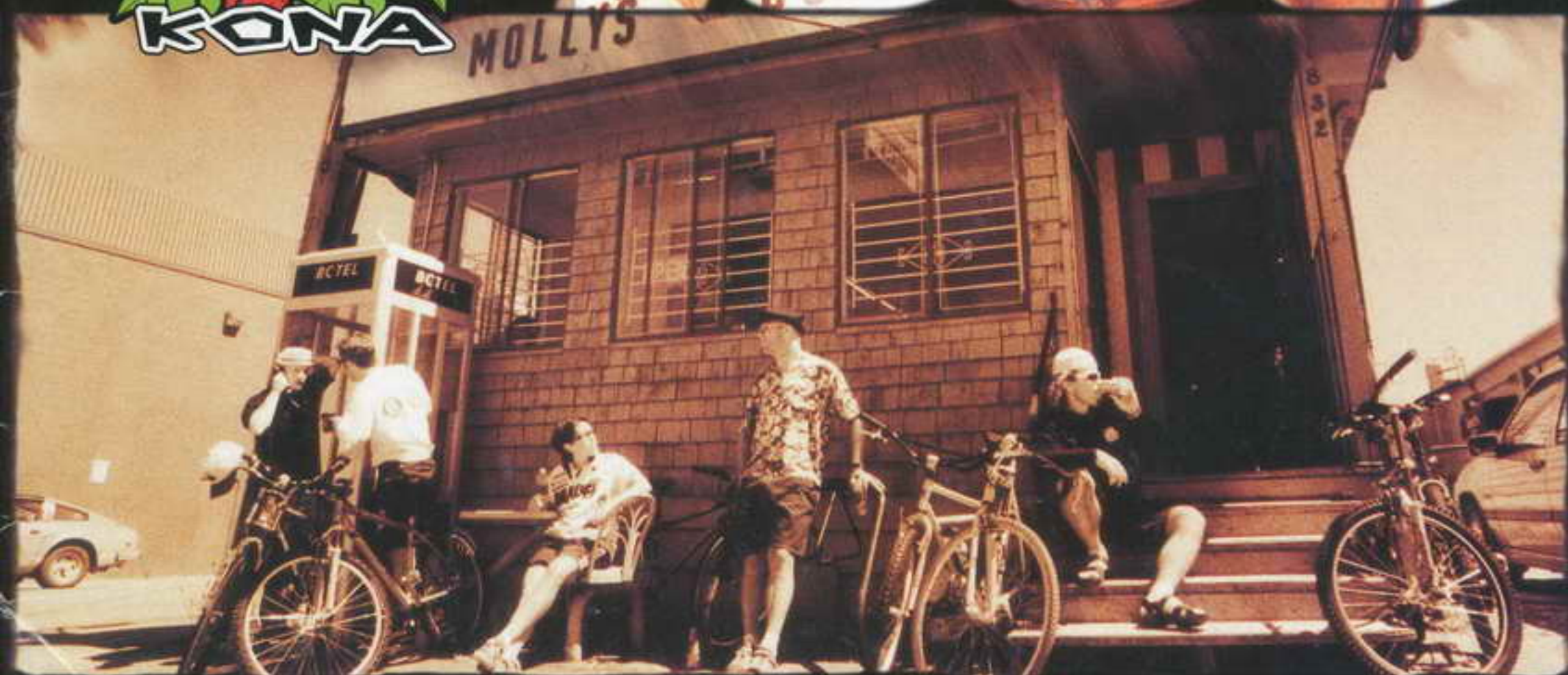

During 1998 the Stab proved itself at countless races: the privateer's trump card! Surprisingly, the Stab was the first Kona production bike to be used exclusively on a racetrack. Using this race experience Kona has developed two new Downhill designs.

The Stab Dee-Lux with 7" travel front and rear has been raced by Stefano Miglorini of the Mapei-Kona team in the Grundig World Cup Series. This awesome, no compromise, tried and tested machine is aimed at the Pro World Cup rider, just check out the spec!

The Stab has 5" travel front and back and continues the Kona theme which enables the privateer racer a Stab at a World Cup event — the bike won't let you down, only your experience. You gain experience by racing and the Stab gets you started with out compromising performance.

Read on...(quotes from an ex-hardtail rider!):

"Unlike a coil over shock, the spring is air (how light do you want to go?). It's not influenced by pedalling motion and the pedalling forces don't effect the suspension. The bike jumps up and over technical sections with plenty of energy return, yet still remains very controlled and smooth on rough downhill.

Full suspension bikes come in many guises.

Kona have produces three specific categories:

Down Hill, Out of Bounds and XC (Cross Country).

This shock will have a huge impact on the full suspension bikes this year. With this shock, people are going to run out of reasons to not buy full suspension."

Kona XC full suspension bikes use an Active frame design derived from the frames used by the DH and OB bikes. The design emphasis was to keep weight down and offer the classic Kona ride with the advantage of full suspension. Add to this a Fox Air Vanilla Shock and you get the ultimate active but responsive design.

Cross country racing or just cruising the scenery in comfort: this is the future of full suspension for most riders.
