The MASI Gran Criterium has gained world-wide acclaim as The Superb Road Machine. The list of professional and amateur bicyclists who belong to the MASI Gran Criterium family is a list of the "Who's Who" of bicyclists. Stars like Eddy Merckx owns over twenty MASIs. The list of Americans riding the MASI Gran Criterium is growing by leaps and bounds since the founding of a MASI factory in southern California.

There is even more at stake now in the sport of bicycle racing and, with that being so, even more MASIs are in demand. A champion is always copied but, somehow, never duplicated.

The frames are made of Reynolds 531 or Columbus (Pista) double butted tubing throughout. Sizes range from 50 centimeters through 64 centimeters. Lugs and Crank Box are of our own investment-cast design. We are the first company to implement investment-casting throughout — we are so advanced that MASIs are now in their *second generation* of investment-casting design! This type lug and crank box are the most expensive and

strongest designs ever used. Handle Bar and Stems are engraved light alloy with recessed head. Saddles are non-slip suede professional leather with Campagnolo Super Record seat post. Pedals are always Campagnolo Superleggeri. The Deraillleur is Campagnolo Super Record. Brakes are Campagnolo Super Record. Crank and Chainwheel are Campagnolo Super Record. Hubs are Campagnolo small flange quick release type and the wheels are professional aluminum rims, special steel spokes and silk tubulars. Accessories include: Campagnolo fittings, toe clips and straps, water bottle, holder and, Silca pump.

Colors available include champagne, light blue and



dark blue, turquoise blue, silver, dark grey metallic and orange-red or, your special color upon request. All finishes are truly a baked-on finish! In an old world manner, each coat is hand-rubbed and reapplied and then baked at over 400°F. A process so involved that it isn't done in Europe anymore! There is no assembly-line mentality at MASI.
