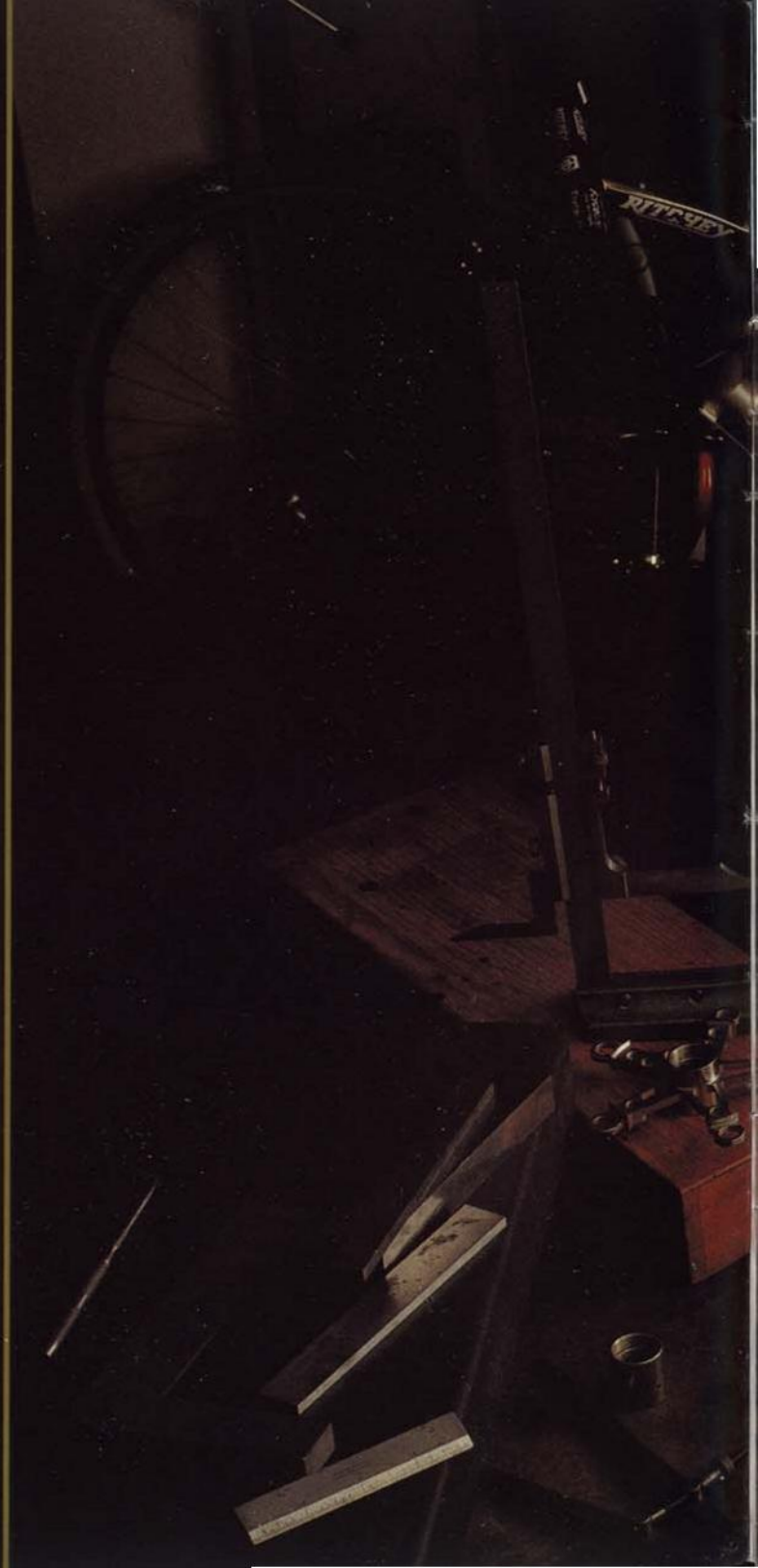


BREEZER

Lightning

At a weight this low, you might expect the Lightning to cut corners. But it's all here: 2.1-inch tires, bar ends, even clipless pedals. The Lightning is built up with a rock-solid component mix that includes the tried-and-true XTR Rapid-

fire Plus shifters and brake levers. And then there's the matchless Breezer ride: *Bicycle Guide* called the '92 Lightning "a real pleasure to ride, a well-balanced beauty that goes where you point it without hesitation or nervousness."

Beamer

The Beamer's Softride® suspension system offers up to four inches of travel in the beam and two inches in the stem. Integrating the rider into the suspension equation gives the rider control, allowing latitude to absorb small and large

bumps. The light Powercurve® frame provides a rigid base for sprinting power. The Beamer's low weight and clean lines prompted *Mountain Bike Action* to call it "the finest example of an Allsop suspension bike we have ever seen."

Jet Stream

This bike offers a superb combination: The sub-four-pound Logic Prestige frame is paired with an all-star cast of components that includes Smoke and Dart 2.1-inch Kevlar tires, a Bontrager titanium-rail saddle, and eight-speed

Grip Shift. After testing the '93 Jet Stream, *Mountain Bike Action* was moved to praise, "[F]ew bikes have consistently been as pleasing to the eye, and enjoyable to ride, as the steel bikes designed by Joe Breeze."

Thunder

Everything just right

The Thunder serves up the same great Breezer ride with slightly varied ingredients. It features custom chrome-moly tubing and carefully selected components like Shimano XT derailleurs, Onza bar ends, Smoke/Dart tires, and double-buttressed spokes. In a review of

the '93 Thunder, Germany's *Bike Sport News* observed: "The steering/handling of the Breezer is first-class. . . . [I]t is impossible to find anything negative to say about the riding qualities of this bike. . . . No extreme measurements or angles, everything just right."

Storm

A real contender

The Storm offers full Breezer performance, with the requisite low weight and superb handling. Spec highlights included heat-treated chrome-moly tubing and Shimano's new STX group, with a significant upgrade to LX cranks making this bike a real contender. The fine

wheels use Ritchey Rock rims, Smoke/Dart tires and 15-gauge spokes. All of the details come together to produce the Storm's indescribably nice ride, which, wrote *Mountain Biking* in 1992, "just seems to have an intangible quality that envelops you."



Venturi

This light, responsive road bike has a downsized frame, with a shorter seat tube and proportionally longer top tube than a traditional road bike. This design provides superior lateral rigidity, higher pedaling efficiency and greater comfort. The 5-degree stem takes a shortcut to

the handlebars, putting the stem's extension tube in alignment to best resist sprinting torque. *Road Bike Action* loved the '93 Venturi: "Worth the money and worth any expenditure of time to ride it. Joe, you certainly haven't lost touch with the road bike world."

Details



Breezer frames are made of steel. Three times stiffer than aluminum and twice as stiff as titanium, steel is also in the most advanced state as a bicycle tubing material. Breezer frames are joined by lugless welding. Although welding takes longer than other joining methods, it is stronger per weight, and by avoiding "dead zones" near joints, it allows for livelier, more resilient frames. All joints on Breezers are carefully designed and constructed for optimum strength and efficiency. In fact, everything on a Breezer, big and small, is there for a reason. The thoughtful integration of many elements is the essence of Joe Breeze's design and the foundation of every Breezer's high performance.



Wide spacing of top and down tubes gives greatest frame strength per head tube length. Head tube bottom is externally butted. Shift housing stops are brazed onto head tube to avoid heat stress to down tube and are positioned for maximum brake-cable clearance. New AheadSet system gives stronger, stiffer and lighter stem connection.



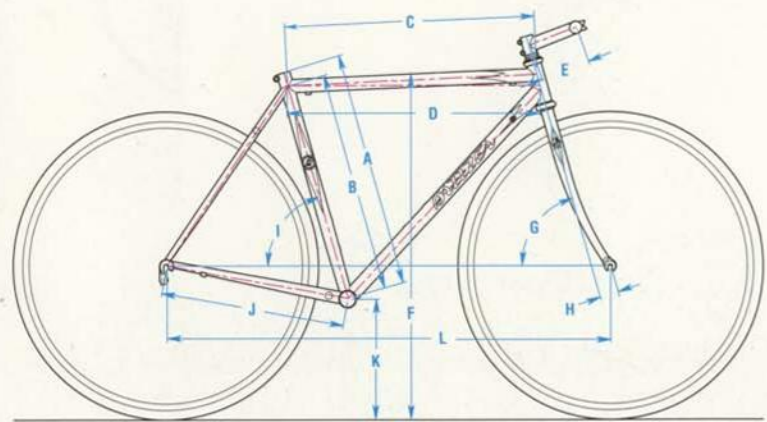
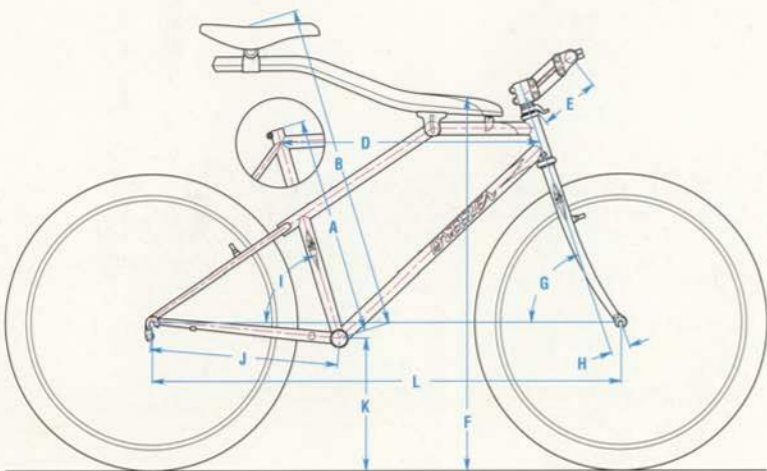
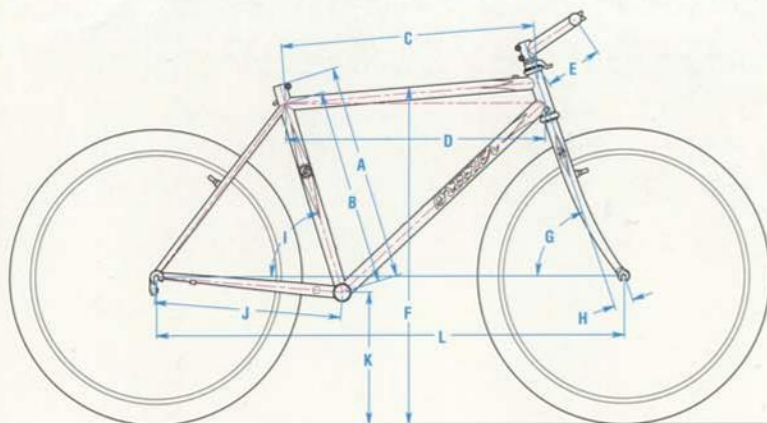
Bulge-buttet seat tube is stronger and straighter than common sleeved type. New "snake tube" brake slider blazes a light and efficient path for the rear brake cable. Placing QR binder slot on front of seat tube reduces inflow of water and grime off rear wheel. Scalloped seat binder (not seen in this view) prunes weight.



Breeze-In™ dropouts provide light, rigid support, with half the weight and twice the stiffness of standard dropouts. They maximize the efficient power transmission of the chainstays and bolster the rear derailleur for better shifting. Ramped faces smoothly guide hub into frame.



Steel tubing is precisely butted to add strength and pare weight. Seat tube is flared and elliptical at bottom bracket, forming a larger cross-section that resists pedaling-induced lateral flex. Shimano's Torlon cable guides fight friction for smooth shifting even when bone-dry.
