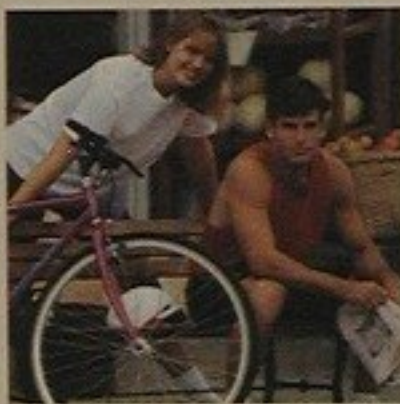

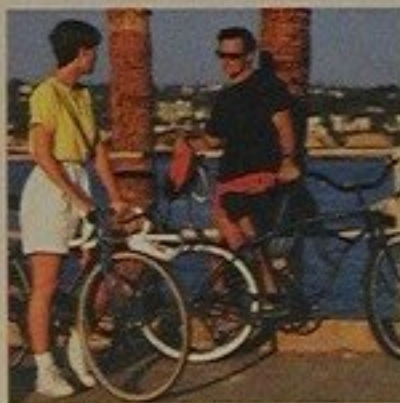

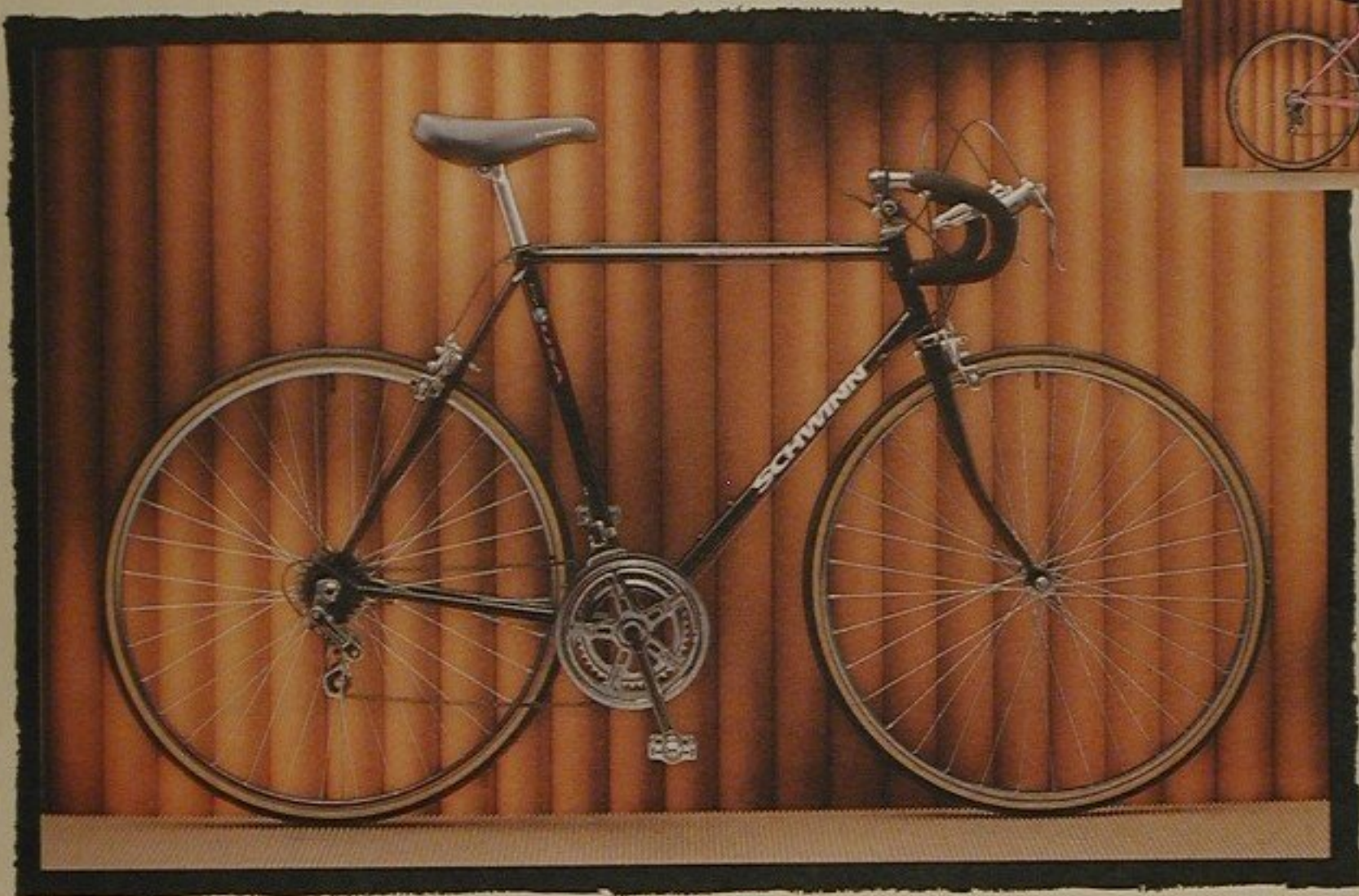

3: Value. As we like to say, value isn't how much you pay. It's how much you get. And value is why Schwinn has been America's favorite bicycle for four generations.

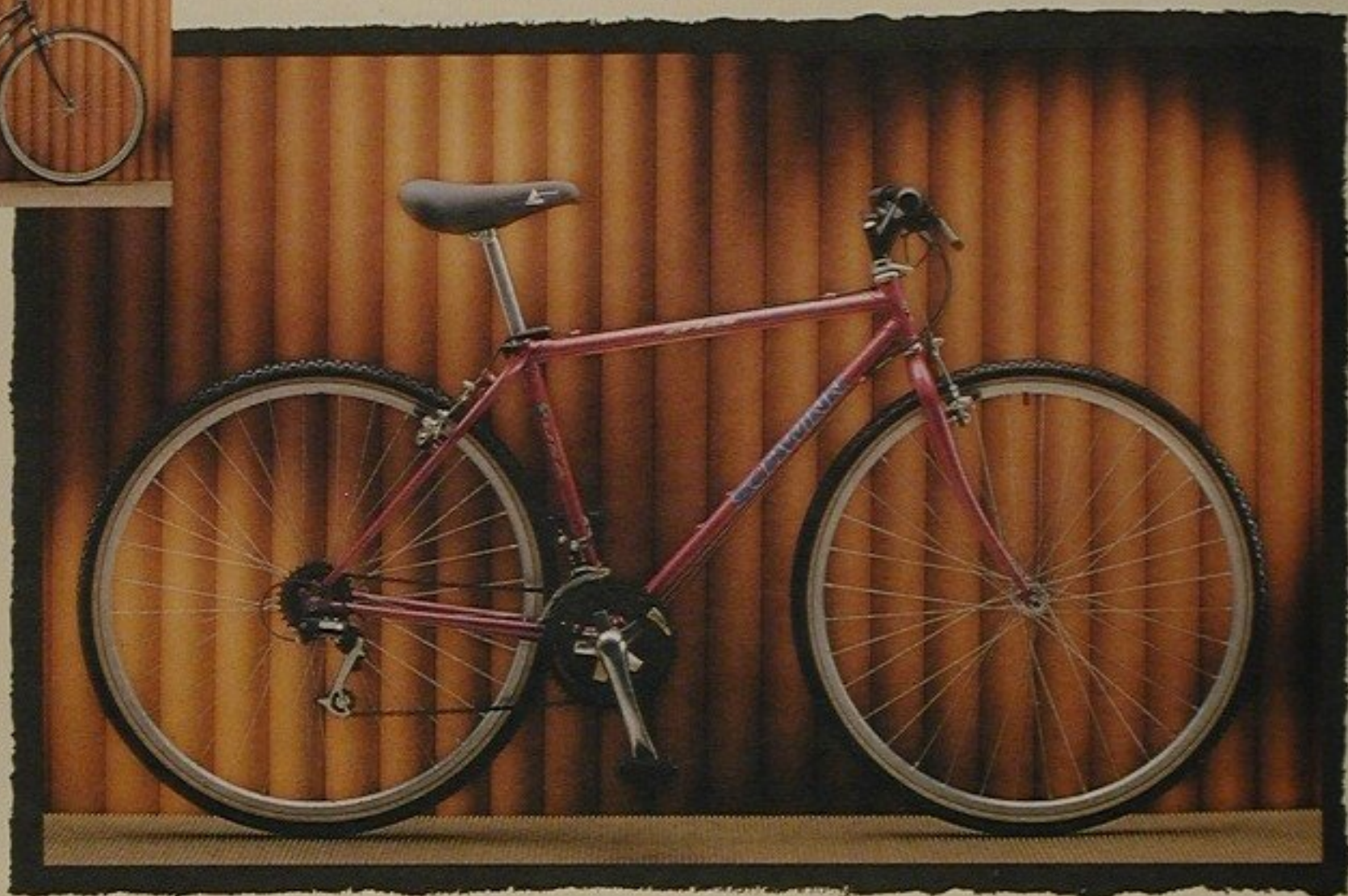

IMBA's Rules of the Trail:

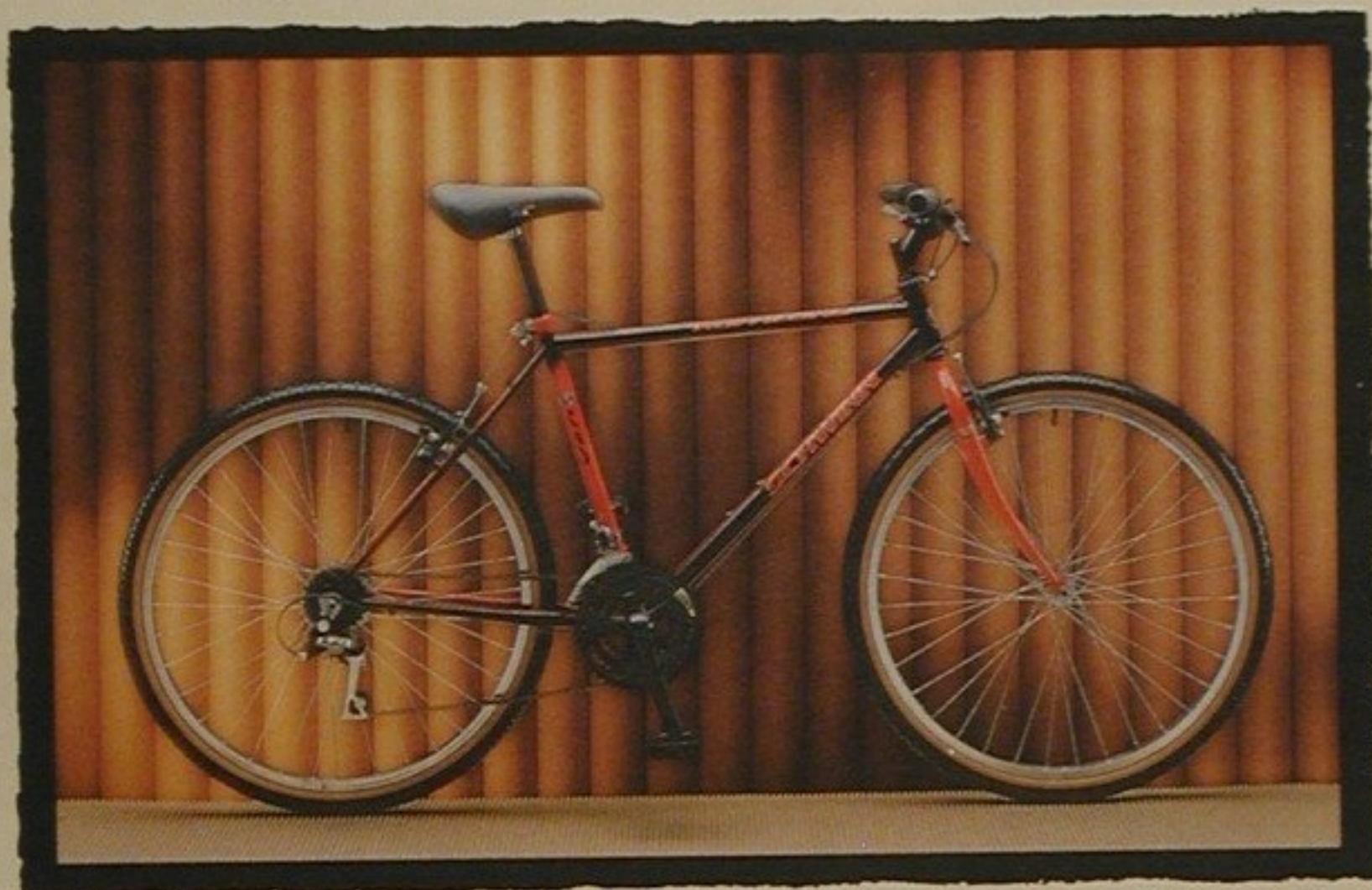
Rules of the (Off) Road:
Riding Responsibly

1. **Ride on open trails only.** Respect trail and road closures.
2. **Leave no trace.** Be aware of the dirt beneath you.
3. **Control your bicycle.** Inattention for even a second can cause disaster.
4. **Always yield the trail.** Make your approach known well in advance.
5. **Never spook animals.** Give animals extra room and time to adjust to you.
6. **Plan ahead.** Know trail conditions, your ability, and the area in which you are riding—and prepare accordingly.

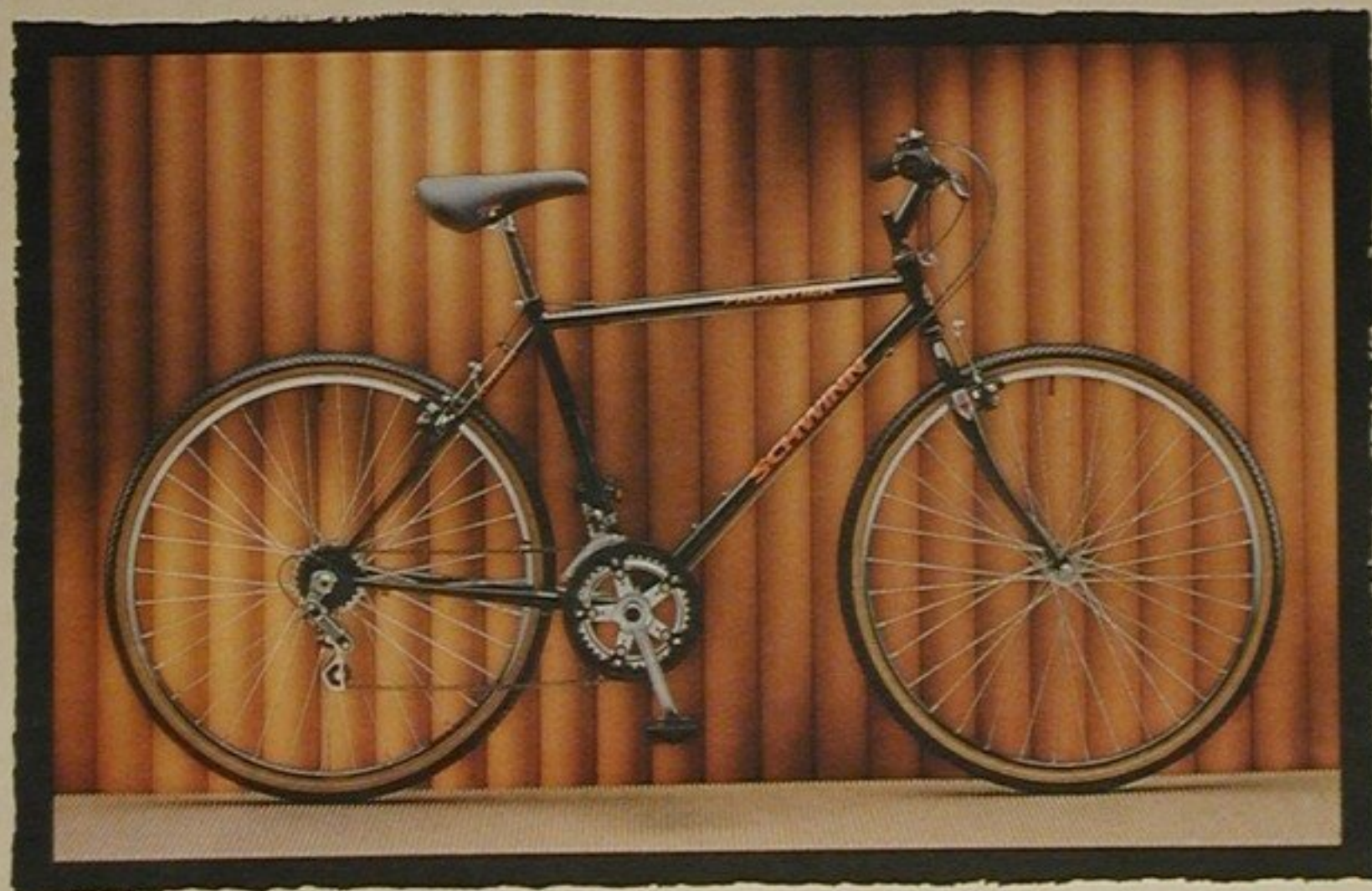

And getting a racing license is easy. Just call NORBA at 719/578-4717 to receive materials by mail. You can even get a "one day" license right at the race.

Finding events to ride is even easier: just ask your local Dealer. Chances are there's someone in the store who rides competitively, and bike shops are full of flyers and race announcements.

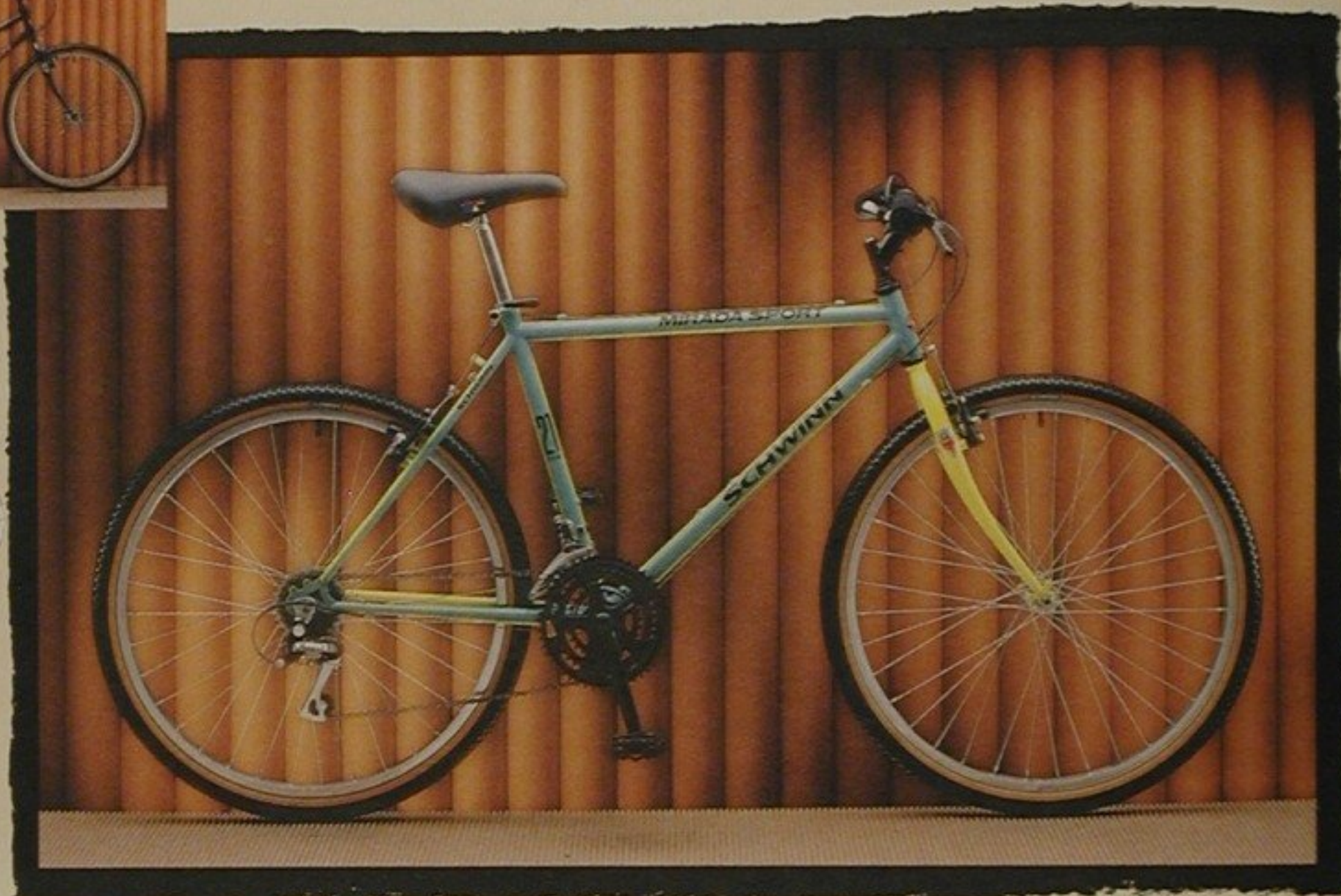

What to look for in Your First Mountain Bike. Bikes from different manufacturers often have the same components. So what's the difference? Here's some guidelines to get you started.

Start by looking at the frame. Better quality frames use large-diameter steel tubing for higher strength, lighter weight, and better frame stiffness. (MOS is Schwinn's trade name for its Mountain OverSize tubing.)

Next, take a look at fork rake—that's the way the fork curves to connect the frame to the front wheel. Best are forks whose rake follows a continuous curve (also called constant-radius forks).

Then be sure to check the warranty. A bicycle should be a lifetime investment: make sure your investment is protected.

Finally, consider the Dealer. A good shop will help you pick out the bike that's just right for you.

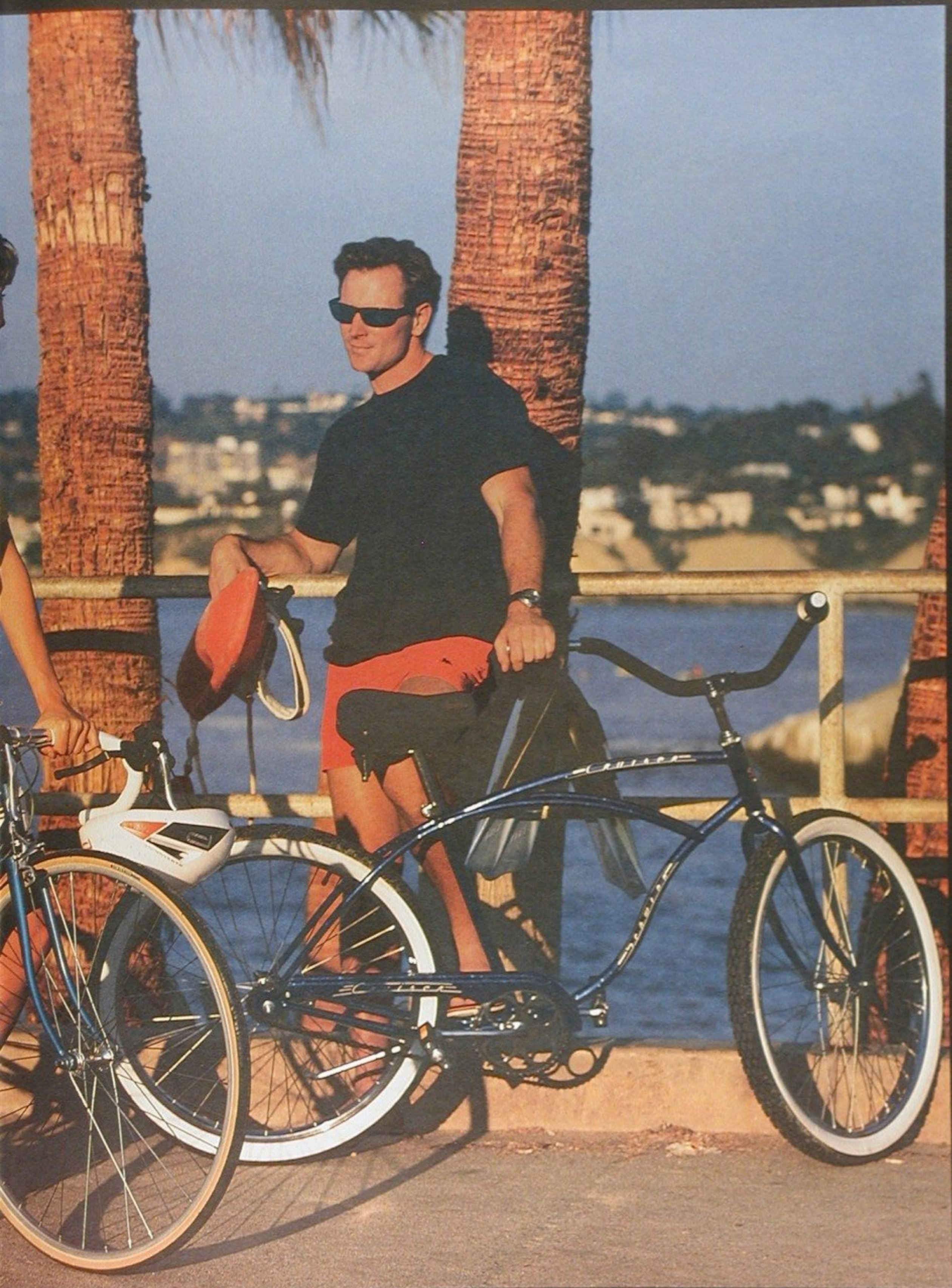

2. Use of products in any competitive event;
3. Use of products for stunt riding, ramp jumping, acrobatics or similar activities, or with motors as power driven vehicles; or

FOR HOW LONG

The warranty coverage has no time limit for all products sold by SCHWINN except electronic components. For electronic components, the warranty coverage runs for two (2) years from the date of purchase.
