With the assistance of a high-tech aerospace machine shop, the C-26's lugs are crafted from chromoly and, after being treated with a Permabond thermal bonding agent and a hot oven, an exotic four-pound frame is produced to make what *Mountain Bike Action* magazine called "... the first truly efficient carbon fiber mountain bike."

Not content with his carbon creation, Herting returned with the Yeti Ultimate. Inspired by the *Mountain Bike Action* project bike that was originally built at the Yeti factory, the design has been refined to create an exciting blend of Yeti traditionalism and modern elevated chainstay concepts. The Yeti Ultimate is attracting attention not so much for the technological achievements it has already surpassed, but for the level of mountain bike savvy that it forces other companies to strive for. Mountain bike technology has entered an exciting new phase with the advent of alternative frame materials. Easton's C-9 tubeset is a state-of-the-art combination of an aluminum core tube covered with a unidirectional high-modulus carbon wrap. The alloy core adds hoop strength and torsional stiffness to the frame while the carbon wrap increases bending stiffness, resulting in a tubeset that is half the weight and twice the strength of 4130 chromoly. The Yeti C-26 is the fruition of many hours of work between our designers and Easton's engineers, giving you the chance to ride the bike of the future today.

All Yeti mountain bike frames are hand-made using only the finest materials and come with a limited warranty. Frames are available with either an electrostatic epoxy powder paint or custom Imron. Each frameset includes frame, fork, Evolution headset, seatpost clamp, cable ferrules and instructions. To the front no excuses—and we'll see you at the races.

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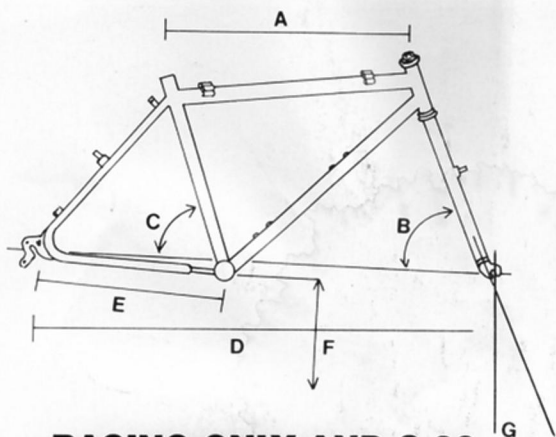
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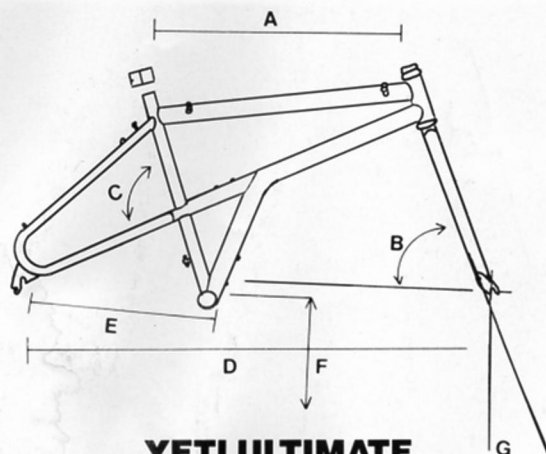
