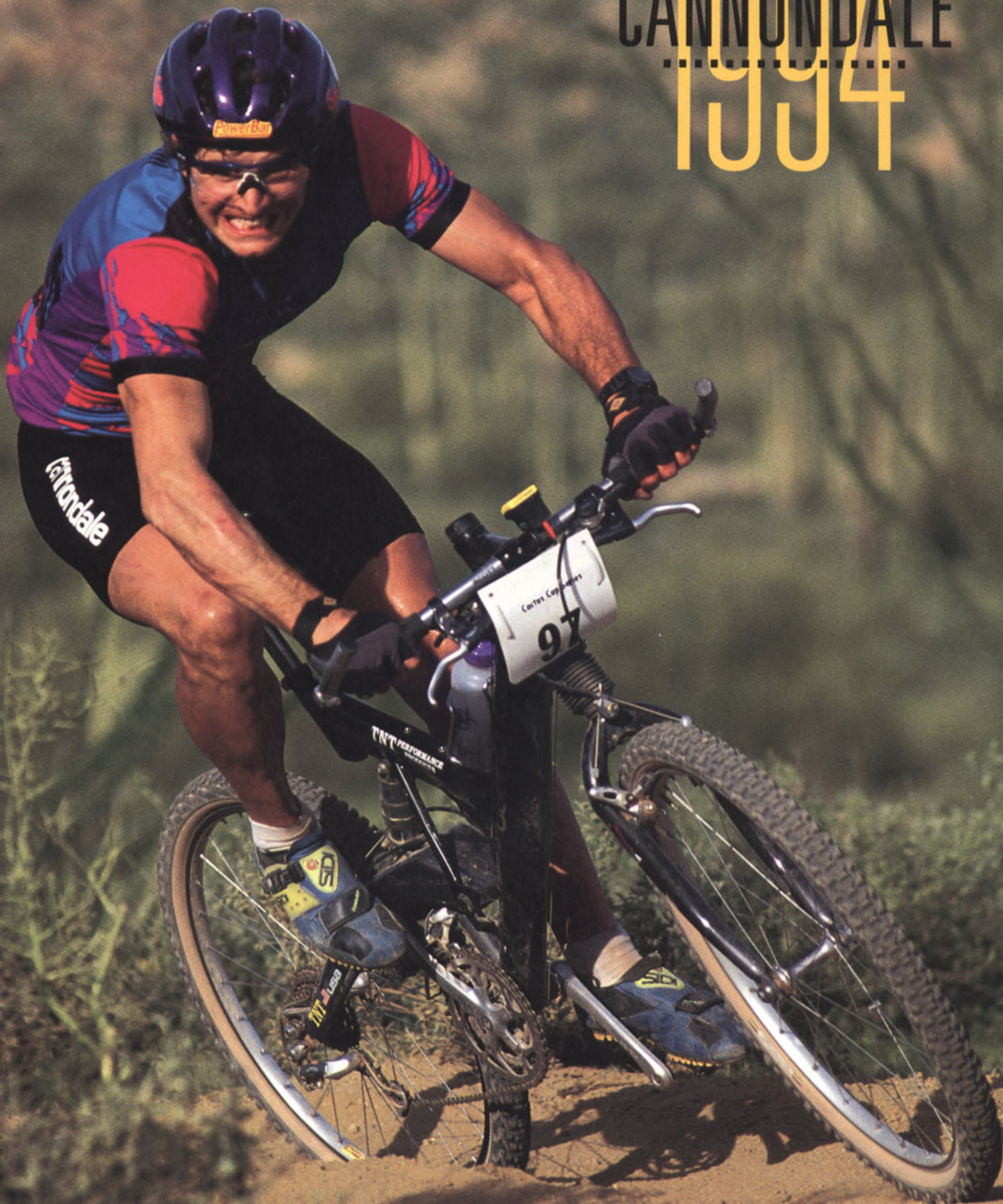

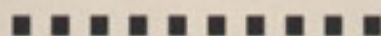

HAND-BUILT FRAMES: PERFORMANCE THROUGH INNOVATION

When it comes to materials for building bicycle frames, it's hard to beat aluminum. Incredibly light, aluminum is 40% less dense than titanium, and a whopping 65% less dense than chrome-moly steel. And it's reasonably priced, so we can offer some of the very lightest frames on the planet at decidedly un-astronomical prices.

Aluminum allows us to use large-diameter tubes that won't flex when you jam on the pedals — doubling a tube's diameter increases its flex-resistance sixteen times — so your energy gets used to power you forward instead of twisting your frame. Other manufacturers use slimmer tubes simply because they have to: A titanium mountain bike frame with the same dimensions as a 3.6 pound Cannondale would be more than two pounds heavier. An identical chrome-moly frame would weigh over 10 pounds.

Crafting raw aluminum into lightweight, high-performance frames is a time-consuming, painstaking process that our craftspeople have been perfecting for over a decade. But just one test ride will convince you that a Cannondale's performance more than justifies the care and effort invested in its production.



Cannondale frames deliver maximum performance through superior innovation. We define innovation as the incorporation of insightful, performance-enhancing elements into bicycle frame design. From the obvious — like the unique configuration of our Super V™ frame — to the subtle — like the grams of weight shaved from Cannondale frames with our CAD system — performance dictates design: not price, not ease of manufacturing, not aesthetic convention.



We use flex-resistant, large diameter 6061-T6 aluminum tubes because they deliver more pedaling energy to the rear wheel for faster sprints, more aggressive climbing and unequalled efficiency. After cutting, tubes are TIG-welded by hand, then heat treated for maximum strength and true, uni-body construction. Our lugless, TIG-welded/heat treated production process is particularly difficult, time-consuming and expensive, but it results in a vastly superior frame.



After heat treating, each weld is carefully sanded for a sleek, seamless look. Sanding is one of the many operations we do by hand to guarantee maximum quality. In fact, over the four-hour course of its production, every Cannondale frame comes into contact with some 40 pairs of human hands.

The same passionate devotion to innovation also drives the production of every Cannondale frame. We use state-of-the-art manufacturing technology to ensure the quality of production matches the quality of design. Pictured at left: A computer-guided laser cuts aluminum tubing to incredibly precise tolerances.



Sanded frames are cleaned and hand-painted, then decals and clear coat are applied. We build our frames into complete bicycles with the latest, lightest and hottest components; not just Shimano and SunTour parts, but everything from Control Tech and Mavic to Profile for Speed and Continental. Finally, completed bicycles are packaged and shipped to progressive, service-oriented bike shops around the world — our network of authorized Cannondale retailers.



Every Cannondale bicycle is made in our U.S. factory, a fact that translates into yet another advantage for every Cannondale owner. With our own American factory, we're able to bring innovative new models to market faster and with greater control than companies sourcing out their production to Far Eastern factories.

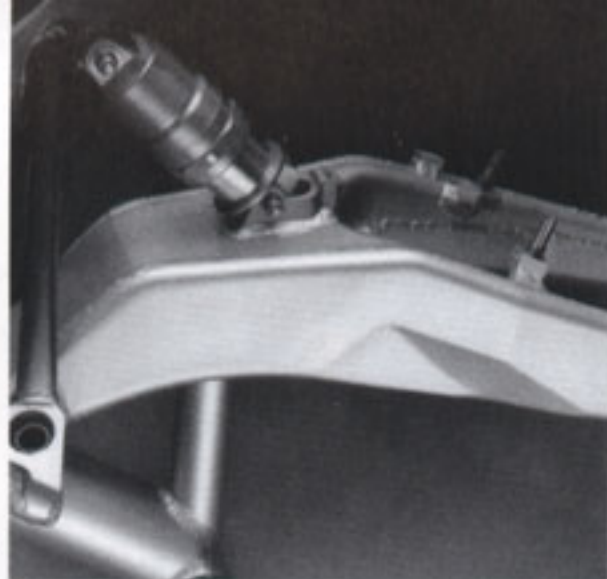
FULL SUSPENSION MOUNTAIN BICYCLES

The Cannondale Super V™ is the first mountain bike to give you the control and comfort of full suspension with the light weight and frame rigidity of conventional frames. At just 4.4 pounds¹, the Super V frame allows us to build full suspension bikes weighing as little as 26 pounds — well within the range of high-performance non-suspended bikes. And the frame's oversized swaged downtube, beefy four-inch pivot and box-section swingarm combine to make the Super V more stubbornly unyielding to flex than our standard-setting 3.0 Series mountain frame.

Sculpted from 6061-T6 aluminum, the Super V has been carefully configured to account for the changes suspension brings to frame geometry: The Super V's head angle corrects the slightly higher front end common to all suspended bikes. Our S.S.™ (Suspension Specific) stem positions the rider in the same efficient pose found on non-suspended bikes. And the teardrop seat mast gives unmatched stand-over clearance.

The Super V comes with the air-sprung, oil-damped Headshok™-RDC or Headshok-DD suspension fork (see page 11) and an air-sprung, oil-damped rear shock that provides three inches of rear wheel travel. Together the front and rear suspensions soak up all manner of bone-rattling ruts and bumps, freeing your wheels to follow the subtle contours of the most undulating trails.

Composed of four precision-formed panels that took the better part of a year to develop, the Super V's reinforced box-section aluminum swingarm teams with a four-inch pivot to provide incredible rear end stiffness. The swingarm comes equipped with our patented² replaceable rear derailleur hanger; a trick feature that turns a potentially frame-trashing mishap into a minor inconvenience.

The Super V 3000 and Super V 2000 (and also the Delta V 1000) feature our new Headshok-RDC suspension fork with the Remote Damping Control Lever™, an indexed, bar-mounted "thumbshifter" that lets you adjust damping on-the-fly without taking your hands off the grips. Compared to other suspension forks which require you to stop and adjust both legs (at best) or disassemble and reassemble the fork (at worst), it's hard to deny the dramatic superiority of the Headshok-RDC's adjustability.

Our Delta V™ models combine a range of suspension options with our innovative, lightweight¹, patented² Delta V frame. The Delta V 1000 features our acclaimed Headshok™-RDC air/oil suspension fork, shown on page 11 (patent pending), and the Delta V 700 and Delta V 600 feature the new Headshok-ELS elastomer-based fork described on page 10. The Delta V 500 comes with our Headshok-ELS2 suspension fork. All three lightweight, telescoping steerer tube systems feature adjustable preload and deliver two inches of front wheel travel.

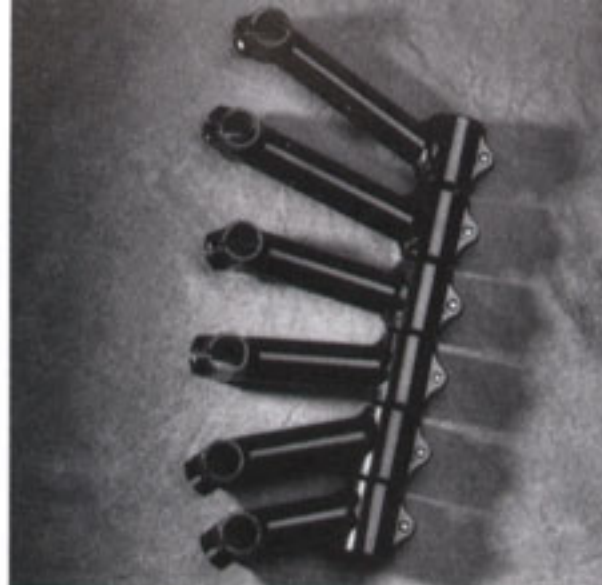
With its uniquely configured, large-diameter aluminum tubes, the Delta V frame provides exceptional stand-over clearance and unyielding resistance to frame flex. Each model also comes outfitted with powerful Force 40 Plus™ braking³, a method of rerouting brake cables to boost stopping power by 40% over standard cantilevers. Another trick feature — our patented⁴ replaceable rear derailleur hanger — protects a vulnerable frame area from permanent damage.

At roughly 165 grams, our lightweight aluminum S.S.™ (Suspension Specific) stem replaces a standard stem to shave about a half a pound off the Delta V's weight. The S.S. stem also addresses the elevated front end common to all suspension forks, repositioning the rider in the same efficient position perfected on non-suspended mountain bikes. For a totally dialed-in fit, we offer six different S.S. stems, each of which can be inverted on the bike, for a total of twelve rider-position options.



Super V and Delta V models (except the Delta V 500) come equipped with our rugged, cartridge sealed-bearing headset; very possibly the finest headset in the industry. Dramatically oversized to accommodate our suspension forks, the headset features ABEC-3 aircraft-quality bearings and the convenience of an adjustment-free design.

HEADSHOK™-ELS FORK¹

The Headshok-ELS's adjustable preload sets precisely to your weight with a few quick turns of a four millimeter allen wrench. (Setting the preload does not cause any loss in travel.)

A low-durometer urethane bumper cushions the fork, should it reach the limit of its travel.

Our lightweight telescoping steerer tube delivers two inches of travel. Steering is stable and dependable because there's none of the uneven blade compression endemic to other suspension forks.

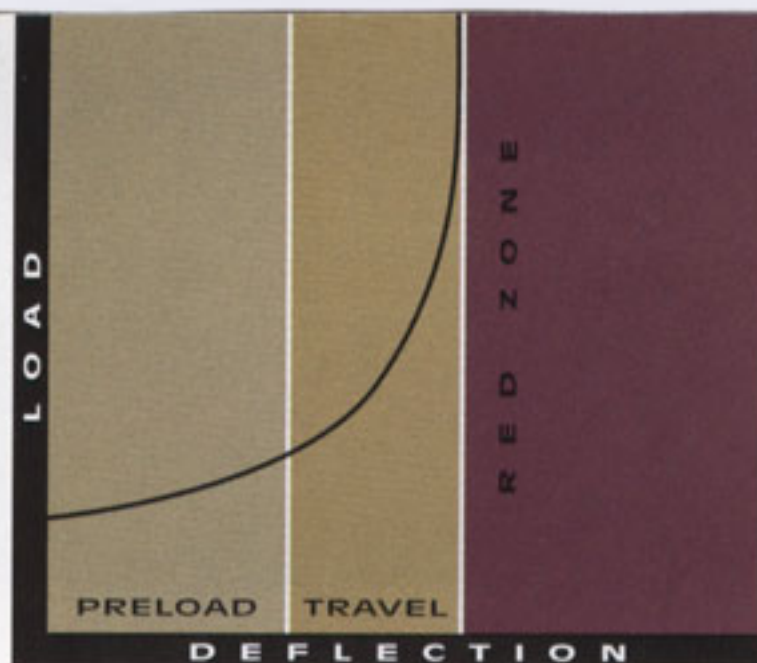
A low-durometer urethane top-out bumper helps cushion the Headshok-ELS's rebound after major impacts.

The Headshok-ELS can be easily upgraded to an air-sprung/oil-damped Headshok-RDC or Headshok-DD fork with parts available from your Cannondale retailer.

The Headshok-ELS's telescoping steerer tube rolls easily on 88 needle bearings, dramatically boosting the fork's responsiveness to small impacts. Stiction, the clingy static friction common to forks with cuff-like bushings between the telescoping tubes, is virtually eliminated.

Our 6.25 inch, volume-compressible urethane shock damper has both a longer fatigue life and better load-deflection characteristics than elastomer bumpers (see charts above). Its long load-deflection curve also delivers the proper shock damping characteristics for all riders, eliminating the need to disassemble the fork to mix and match bumpers.

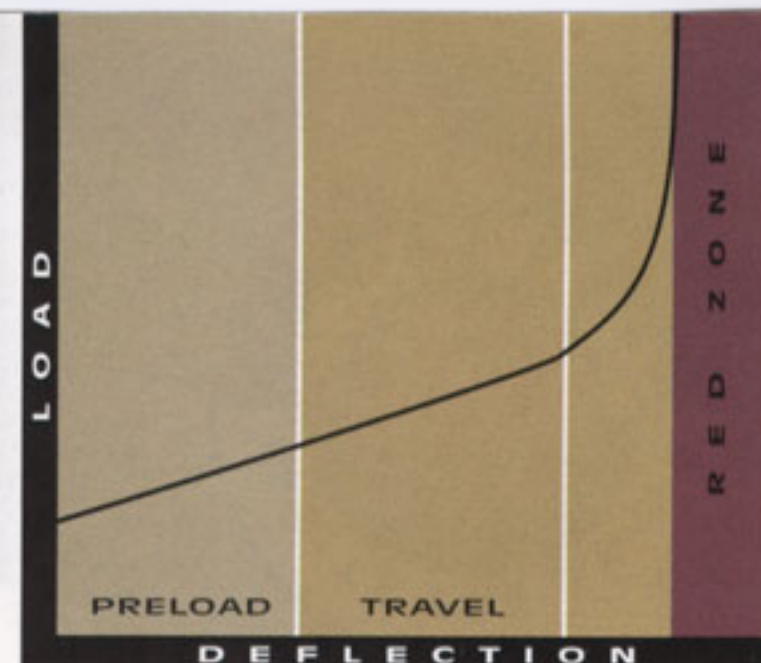

STANDARD ELASTOMER

As the chart above shows, standard elastomers absorb shock pretty well to a certain point. Beyond that point, the bumpers enter the "red zone", becoming rigid and losing the capacity to absorb additional shock.

The bottom line: Standard elastomer-based forks do well on smaller bumps, but you take a beating when you hit anything larger.



CANNONDALE HEADSHOK-ELS

The Headshok-ELS uses a micro-cellular, closed-cell urethane shock damper. Filled with thousands of small air bubbles, the 6.25 inch damper can compress up to four inches. Thus, only a portion of its compressibility is used to provide the fork with two inches of travel. The damper and the fork never enter the deadly red zone lurking at the far end of its graph. The rider enjoys a smooth, controlled ride as the fork scarfs up small and large impacts with equal skill and aplomb.

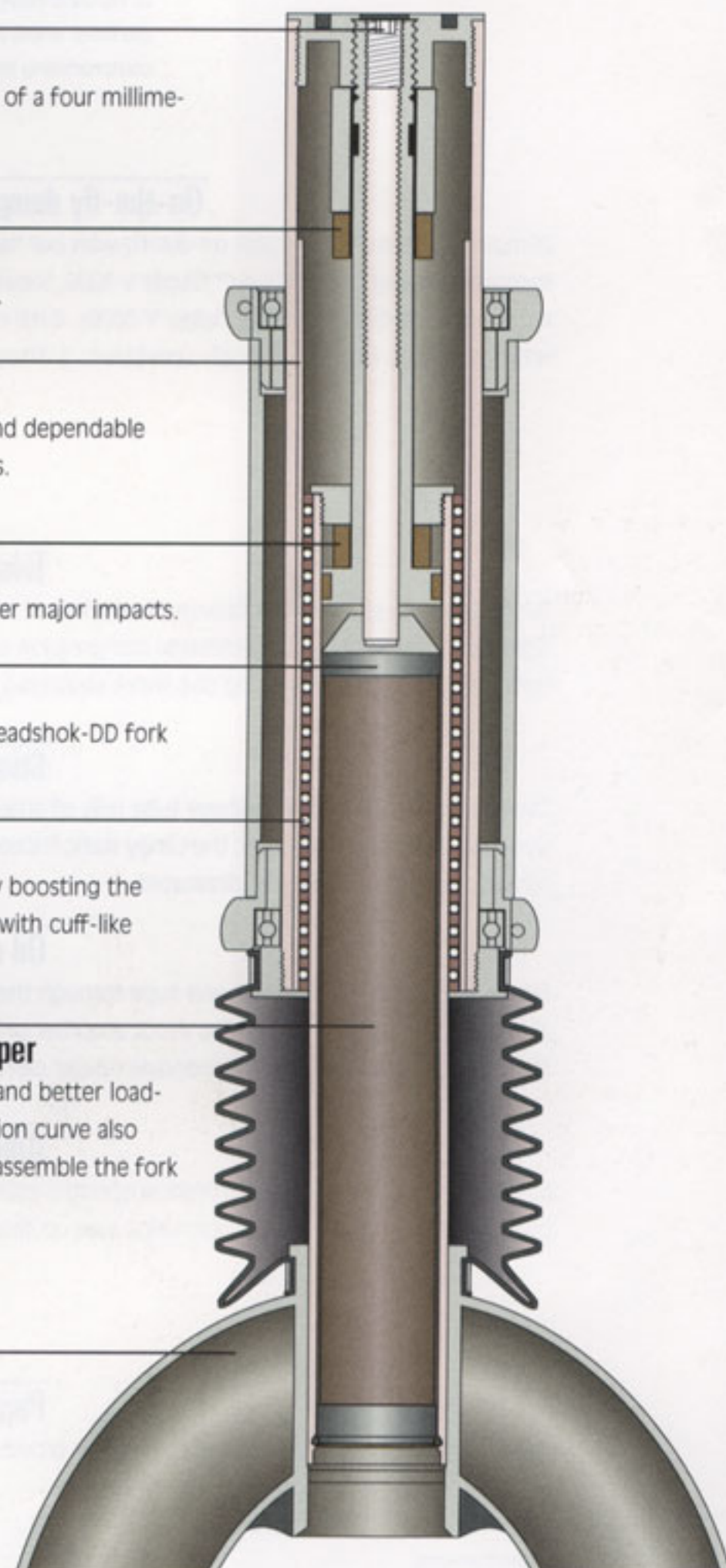

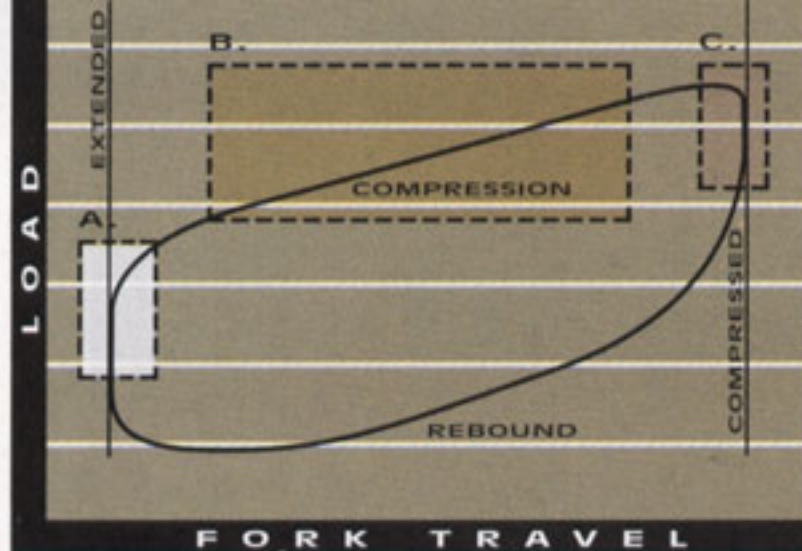

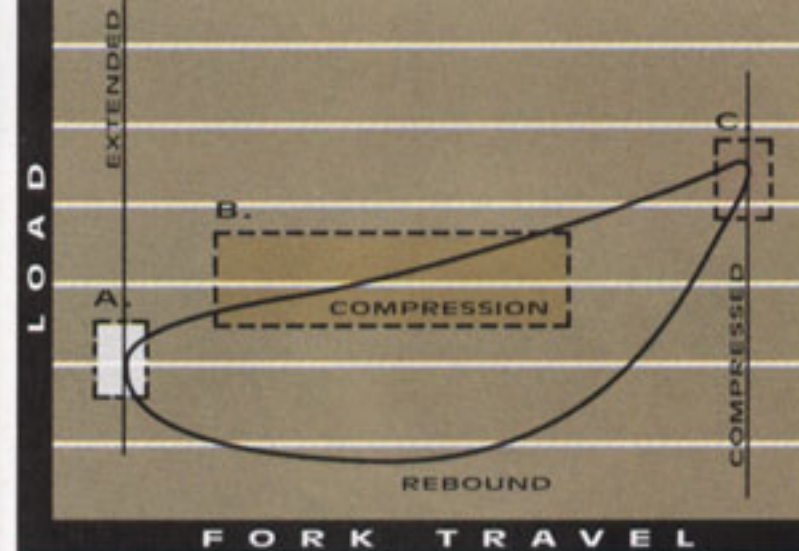


TYPICAL AIR/OIL,
TELESCOPING-BLADE FORK

A. The more vertical distance in this area, the greater the fork's stiction (i.e. the force is increasing without any resulting travel). On the trail, this means that the fork isn't responding to the hundreds of lesser impacts encountered on a typical ride. Instead, the shocks are being absorbed by the rider.

B. The higher the angle in this section, the greater the force required to compress the fork. This high compression ratio translates into less useable travel, as the force required to fully compress the fork is rarely, if ever, generated.

C. This area charts the transition from compression to rebound. The longer the vertical segment, the more time it's taking the fork to rebound (again, due to stiction). With a slow-rebounding fork, the front wheel stays in the air longer after going over a bump, compromising steering and braking control.

FRONT SUSPENSION FORK

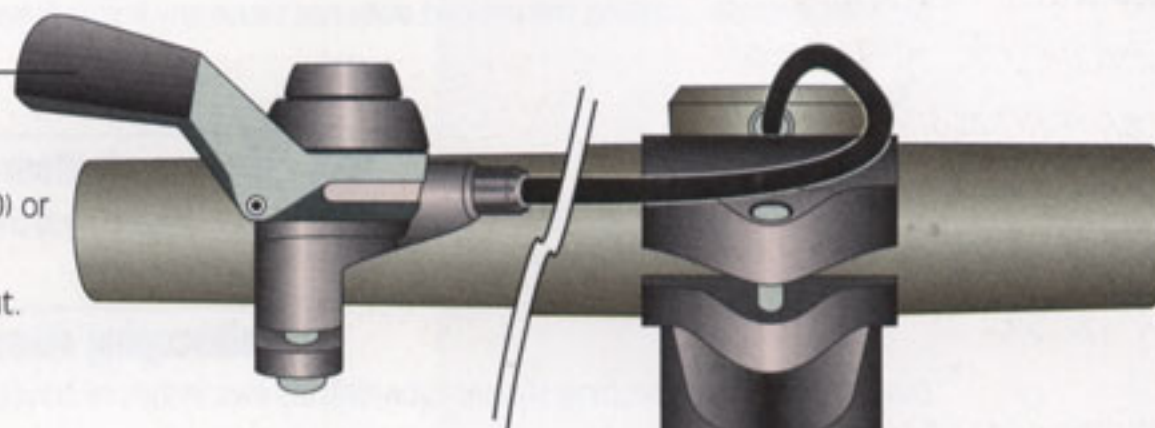
A. The Delta V's virtually stictionless design allows it to react to subtle changes in the trail. As illustrated above, even a slight increase in force (on the vertical axis) causes the fork to compress (the travel indicated on the horizontal axis).

B. This low, gradually sloping segment illustrates the Delta V's carefully engineered compression ratio. All of the fork's travel is useable, yet the fork will only bottom out under the severest impacts.

C. This small vertical distance demonstrates how quickly the Delta V changes from compression to rebound. After hitting a bump, the fork immediately rebounds to keep your tires in contact with the trail for seamless steering and braking control.

On-the-fly damping adjustment

Damping is instantly adjustable on-the-fly with our handlebar-mounted Remote Damping Control Lever™ (Super V 3000, Super V 2000, Delta V 1000) or a stem-mounted Damping Dial (Super V 1000). Each offers four indexed settings ranging from neurotically sensitive to a virtually unyielding lock-out.



Telescoping steerer tube design

Our telescoping steerer tube delivers two inches of impact-absorbing travel and allows the use of rigid fork blades. Rigid blades prevent the uneven blade compression and sloppy handling endemic to telescoping-blade suspension forks. And because we're using one shock absorbing element instead of two, our design saves weight.

Stictionless needle bearings

The Headshok's telescoping steerer tube rolls effortlessly on 88 needle bearings, making the fork incredibly responsive to small impacts. Stiction, the clingy static friction common to forks with cuff-like bushings between the telescoping tubes, is virtually eliminated.

Oil damping

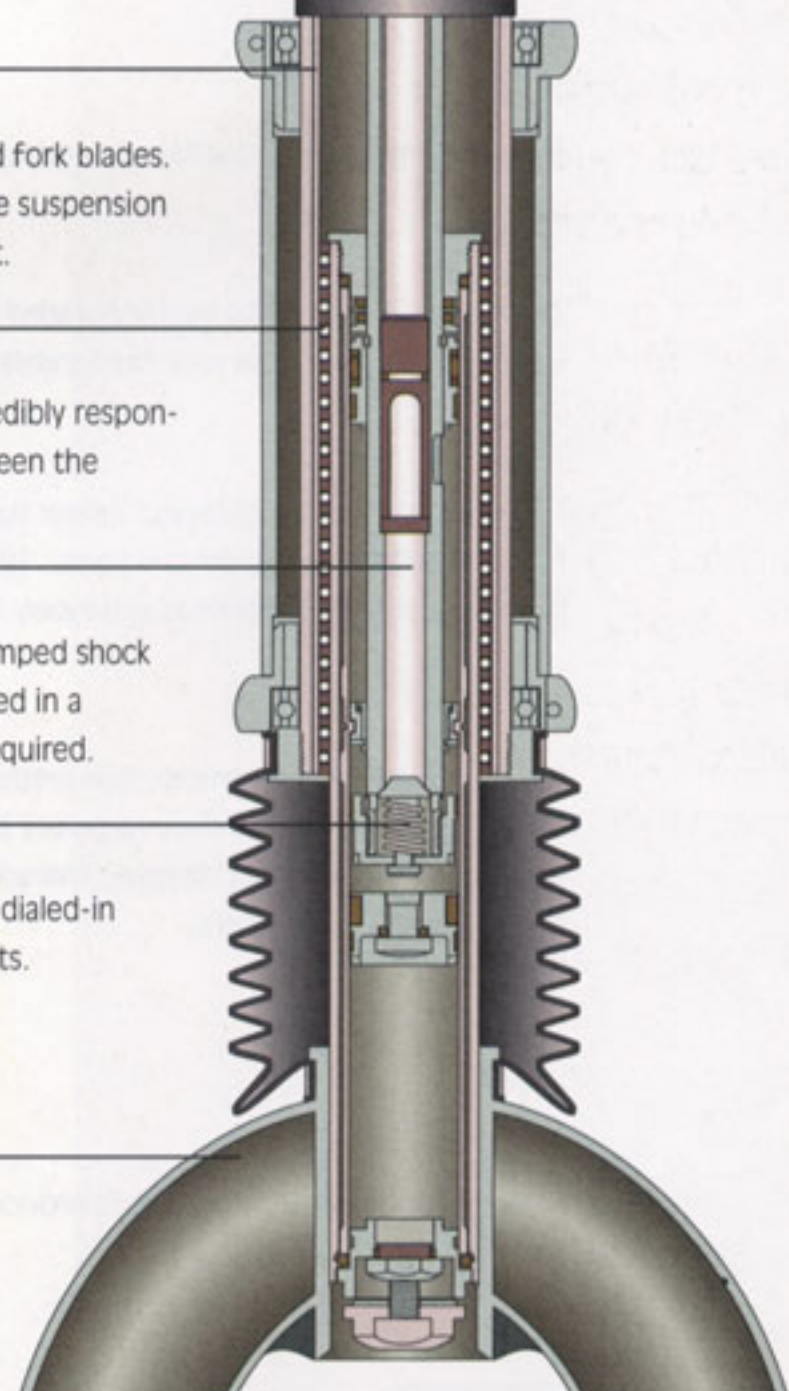
The movement of the inner steerer tube through the outer tube is controlled by an adjustable, oil-damped shock absorbing mechanism. The entire shock absorber unit (air spring and oil-damped mechanism) is housed in a compact cartridge that your Cannondale retailer can swap out in moments should servicing ever be required.

Adjustable air spring

The fork's Schraeder valve-controlled air spring is easily customized to the rider's weight for a precise, dialed-in preload setting. The air spring also helps soak up shocks and keeps the fork extended between impacts.

Pepperoni™ fork blades

Super-rigid, lightweight Pepperoni fork blades provide sure, dependable tracking.

While we were busy developing our first suspension fork in 1991, we were also hard at work designing a reconfigured, suspension-compatible mountain bike frame. The Delta V™ frame, introduced in 1992, succeeded in meeting three key design criteria; suspension compatibility, increased strength and added crotch clearance.

The understanding that extra strength and crotch clearance are at least as important with a non-suspended bike has led to our new Killer V™ frame¹. Combining a Delta V-style top tube with our proven 3.0 Series™ mountain frame geometry, the Killer V reinforces the vulnerable head tube/down tube junction. And the Killer V's unmatched stand-over clearance helps prevent unanticipated, falsetto-inducing encounters with the top tube.

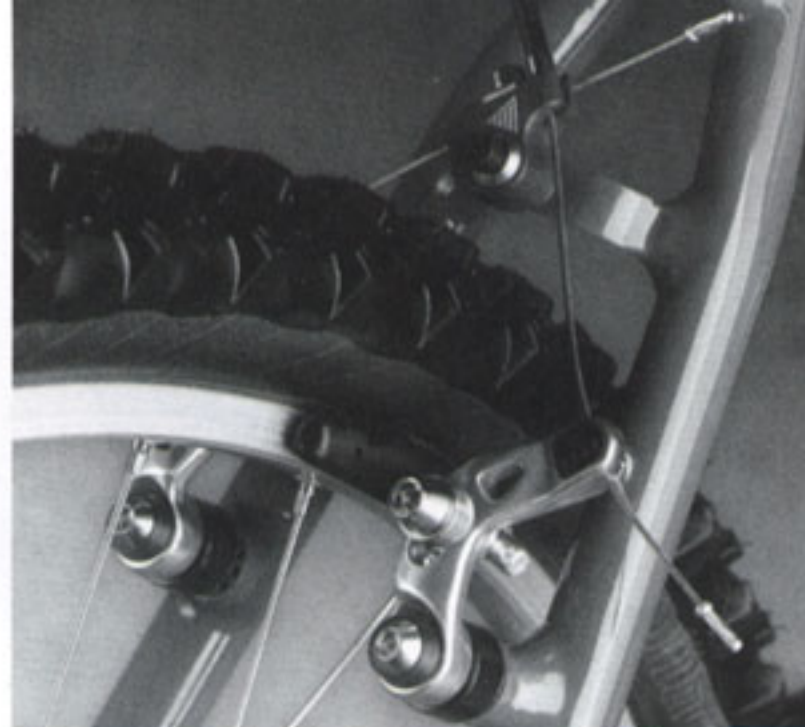
At 3.4 pounds², the Killer V is also among the lightest frames available anywhere. Yet despite its light weight, the Killer V is even more efficiently flex-resistant than our 3.0 Series mountain frame.

Each Killer V model comes spec'd with our beefy Pepperoni™ fork. The Pepperoni features an oversized 1.25 inch steerer tube that adds strength and allows the use of rugged, oversized headsets. The fork also comes with our incredibly rigid, oversized aluminum blades that deliver predictable, sure-footed steering and control.



Our Force 40 Plus™ braking system (patent pending) reroutes brake cables to boost the stopping power of standard cantilevers by 40%. Featured on the Killer V models, as well as many of our high-end mountain bikes, the Force 40 Plus system inspires confidence and reduces hand and arm fatigue on long descents. (Also shown: Our newly redesigned CODA cantilevers are lighter and far easier to mount and adjust than last year's model. For '94, they also come equipped with new, oversized CODA pads.)

Our 3.0 Series™ mountain bicycles are named for the three key attributes of their 3.0 Series mountain frame — light (3.6 pounds¹) weight, vibration-damping comfort and efficient, responsive performance. For 1994, we're offering four 3.0 Series models with a high-performance geometry designed for flat-out, high-speed stability. (One of these models, the M600, has a sloping top tube for those wanting extra crotch clearance.) And for those who prefer more technical riding, we offer the M800 with our nimble "Beast of the East"™ geometry.

Each model is crafted from flex-resistant 6061-T6 aluminum tubing. Incredibly light despite their massive size, these large-diameter tubes deliver more pedaling energy to the rear wheel for more efficient climbing and higher top speeds. The 3.0 Series mountain bikes also feature lightweight cantilever dropouts equipped with our patented, replaceable rear derailleur hanger, slim Mudcutter chainstays that inhibit mud build-up, and a strong, lightweight butted seat tube. Selected models also come with our sure-stopping Force 40 Plus™ braking system that provides 40% more stopping power than standard cantilevers.

For riders who'd rather finesse their way along an obstacle-strewn trail than bomb down a fire road, we offer the M800 with our Beast of the East frame geometry. With its 13 inch bottom bracket height, the Beast of the East clears rocks and logs that would quickly stymie other bikes. And the frame's sloping top tube provides welcome crotch clearance during those sudden saddle-to-straddle dismounts in uneven terrain.



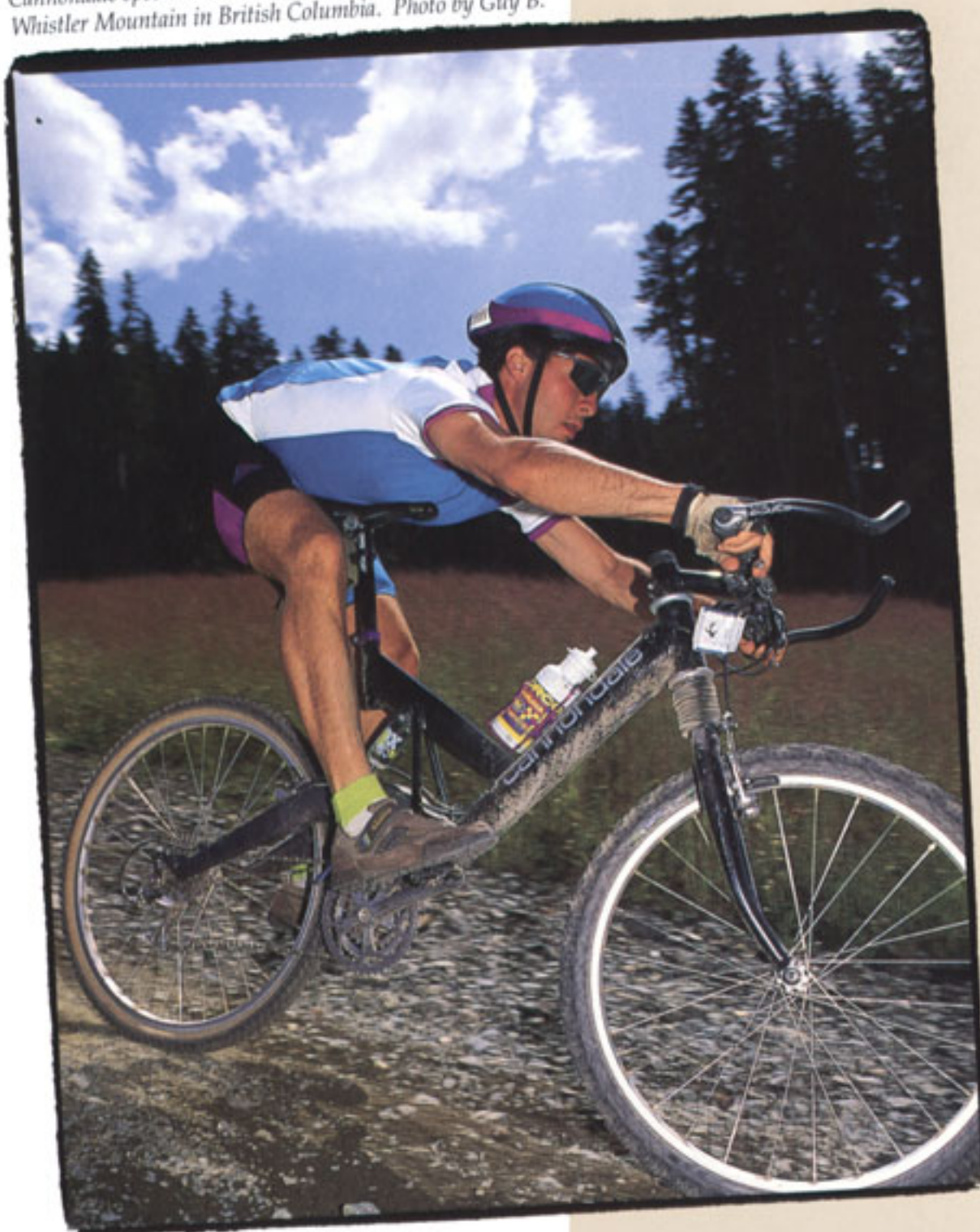
Every Cannondale mountain bike comes equipped with our patented² replaceable rear derailleur hanger. Get a branch jammed in your rear derailleur, or have the derailleur get pushed into the spokes, and the hanger will snap off before any damage can occur to your frame. Secured to the frame with two small allen screws, the hanger can be replaced easily — and inexpensively — in minutes.

FORGET THE GROUP

When we spec components at Cannondale, we start from scratch. The goal is to provide our customers with the very best value possible. In many cases, this requires that we don't use the entire "group" of components provided by a single manufacturer. Many of our competitors take a different approach: They simply check a box on the spec sheet provided by the Taiwanese or Chinese bike factory that builds their bikes for them.

So, for example, you'll see things like the CODA™ crankset on a Cannondale. The CODA crankset is about 50 grams lighter than a comparable crank. And because it's custom-made for us, the CODA crankset can feature a 44 tooth large chainring; a more appropriate choice for the high speeds you'll achieve using our suspension systems. The major component makers won't provide anything but a 42 tooth ring.

Similarly, you'll find a 28 hole CODA Magic™ front hub on many of our bikes. This hub features super-smooth, sealed cartridge bearings while saving a ridiculous amount of weight over a standard hub. We couldn't find an appropriate 28 hole front hub in any "group." The big-name component companies will not provide a rear hub threaded for a drum brake, so we use the gorgeous and pricey Hugi on our MT3000. DID Supershift chains are featured in our line, because they are lighter, more durable and easier to service than the "group" chain.

This same thinking extends to our choice of tires, saddles, stems and handlebars. We're proud that a lot of thought goes into the components on Cannondale bikes.

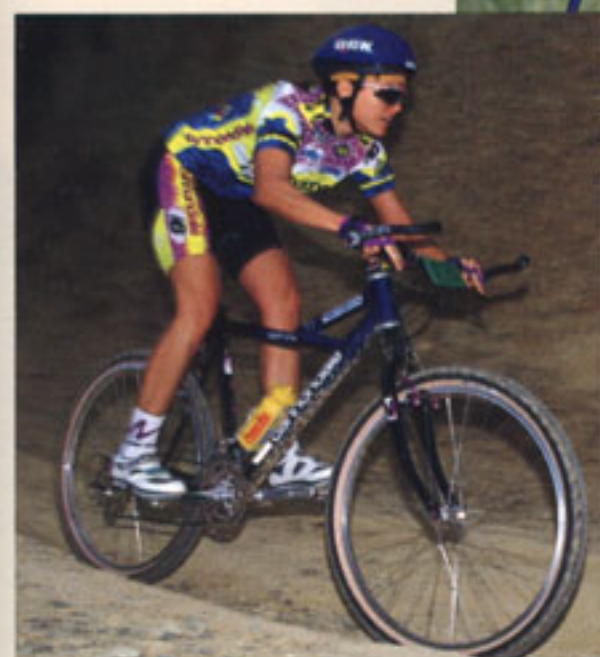

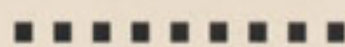

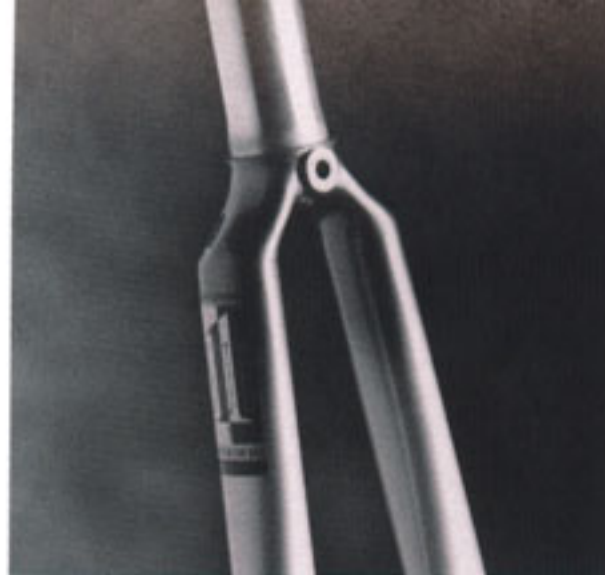

The 3.0 Series racing frame features lightweight cantilever dropouts with our patented, replaceable rear derailleur hanger. The frame's tapered chainstays are thinner near the dropouts for light weight, and beefier near the bottom bracket cluster for resistance to frame flex. A weight-saving butted seat tube provides extra strength near the top tube, and aluminum fork blades soak up vibration for a smooth, comfortable ride.

The R1000 and R700, designed for triathlon, duathlon and time trialing, both feature a specially modified 2.8 Series™ racing frame. The bikes' 75 degree seat tube angle puts the rider in a more aerodynamic position, and allows a multi-sport athlete to use more of the leg power developed through running. A 72 degree head angle supplies more stable steering, allowing the confident use of clip-on handlebars, and 38 centimeter chainstays stiffen the rear triangle for extra efficiency in climbs and sprints.

The R1000 and R700 are sized for 26-inch wheels that are lighter and easier to accelerate than their 700 c counterparts. The smaller wheels also provide better aerodynamics while lowering your center of gravity just enough to increase the bikes' stability.



We've designed our Triathlon/Time Trial frame with a versatile 75 degree seat tube angle. By outfitting the frame with a forward-position seatpost, triathletes and duathletes can effectively steepen the seat angle and make the most of the leg muscles developed through running. By using a straight or "rear-offset" seatpost, athletes can achieve a more traditional riding position.



Although the R1000 is pictured with wheels on this page, you may notice in the spec's on page 47 that wheels aren't included with the bicycle. (We've intentionally left the pedals off too.) Here's why: We've noticed that most experienced triathletes and duathletes have strong opinions about wheels and clipless pedals, and have long-since purchased the specific wheels and pedals they prefer. By eliminating these parts from the R1000 we're able to hold down the retail price of the bike, and prevent the discerning athlete from getting stuck with wheels and pedals they neither want or need.

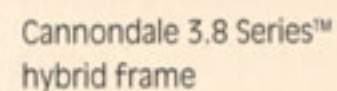

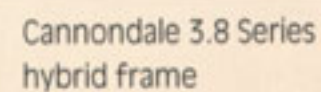

A basic rule of physics: As a tube's length increases, so does the ease with which it can be flexed. Apply the rule to tandem design, and you can see why most tandems are flexible and inefficient: their slim chrome-moly tubing is too susceptible to flexing when used in the lengths required for tandem frames.

A second rule of physics: As a tube's diameter increases, so does its resistance to flexing. In fact, simply doubling a tube's diameter makes it 16 times more flex resistant. If the makers of chrome-moly tandems used large diameter tubing, they'd recapture the stiffness lost by their long tube lengths. But the frame would weigh a ton.

We offer tandems with 26-inch wheels (MT3000, MT2000) and 700 c wheels (RT3000). The aluminum tubes used in their construction are enormous, and they're as long, or longer, than the tubes in chrome-moly tandems. We're able to get away with it, and create a stiffer frame with more stoker (rear rider) room, thanks to the exceptionally light weight of aluminum. In fact, our frames weigh as much as 25% less than chrome-moly frames while blowing them away for stiffness and stoker comfort.



Stokers of all sizes will find they fit comfortably on Cannondale tandems. Our longer rear top tube provides plenty of room for taller stokers, while a fully-adjustable stoker's stem — standard equipment on all of our '94 tandems — provides plenty of adjustability to accommodate shorter stokers.



Our two 26-inch wheel tandems each feature a Pepperoni™ fork with light, beefy, large-diameter aluminum blades. The MT3000's Pepperoni is built with a super-lightweight, oversized titanium steerer, while the Pepperoni on the MT2000 has an oversized chrome-moly steerer.

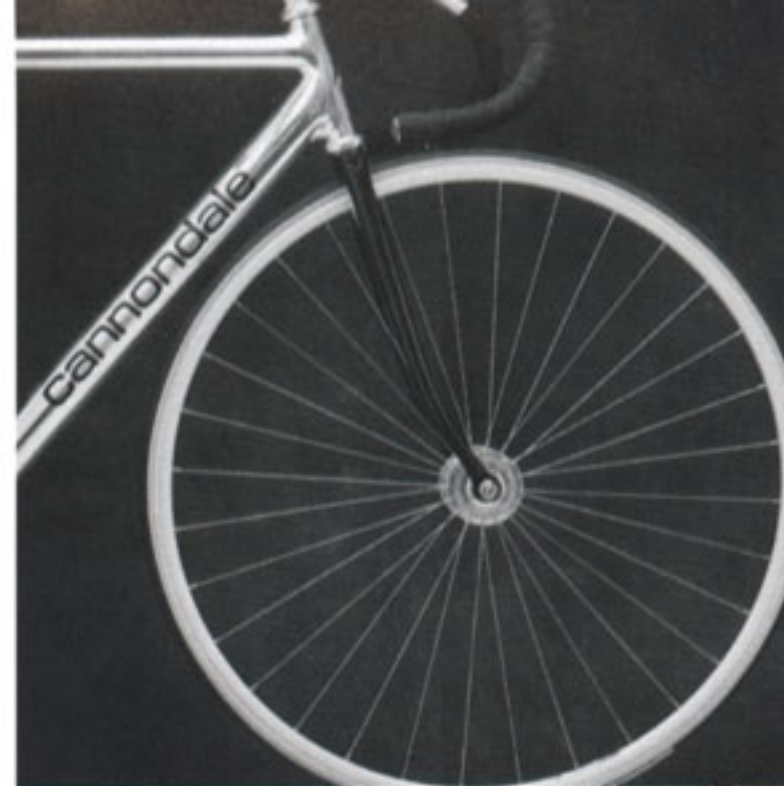
Our 3.0 Series™ track bike is built around our incredibly stiff, exquisitely nimble, 3.25 pound track frame. The stiffness results from the frame's flex-resistant, oversized aluminum tubing — including a super beefy two-inch down tube — that channels pedaling energy directly to the rear wheel. The frame also benefits from its unique double-offset bottom bracket cluster that allows shorter, lighter, more efficient chainstays. A cantilever rear triangle fights flex as well, joining the chainstays and seatstays forward of the dropouts for a lighter, more efficient configuration. The frame features an aggressive 75 degree head angle and a short wheelbase that combine to deliver precise handling, while a slightly sloping top tube¹ keeps the rider in an efficient, aerodynamic tuck.

The 3.0 Series track frame is available as a frameset or on our SunTour Superbe Pro-equipped track bike, and features a top quality chrome-moly track fork with stiff, round blades.

FRAME

At just 3.5 pounds, our new cyclocross frame weighs substantially less than comparable competing models. Along with its light weight, the frame's large-diameter top tube and off-set, top-mounted cable guides provide extra comfort when it's shouldered for unridable course sections.

We've equipped the cyclocross frame with modified Mudcutter chainstays (similar to those used on our mountain bikes) that help prevent mud build-up and ensure plenty of clearance for knobby tires. The frame's slightly elevated bottom bracket increases chainring clearance, and its 43.10 centimeter chainstays contribute to the frame's stability. For lightweight resistance to rear triangle flex, the cyclocross frame features our unique cantilever rear dropouts (complete with an easily replaceable rear derailleur hanger). The frame comes outfitted with a weight-saving butted seat tube, cantilever brake bosses, and a strong, lightweight chrome-moly fork.

Stowaway™ Collapsible Bicycle Trailer (B007)

Our Stowaway trailer features a tough, vacuum-formed polyethylene shell supported by a rugged, lightweight, oversized aluminum frame. Precisely shaped to form a comfortable seat for up to two children, the roomy 21.5" wide interior also provides a firm base for the trailer's rugged aluminum canopy support assembly. The canopy itself is crafted from hefty, high-visibility nylon. Trimmed with reflective piping, the canopy sports front and side mesh panels which provide great flow-through ventilation. In back, a zippered panel provides access to a handy rear storage area.

To keep the Stowaway's center of gravity low, we've equipped it with 20" wheels that are canted slightly inward at the top for added stability. For comfort, the quick-release wheels feature true independent suspension complete with shock absorbing rubber bushings. And the Stowaway connects with your bike via a versatile, adjustable, off-center boom hitch* that attaches easily and securely to an incredible range of bicycles. The hitch's pivot, molded from durable urethane elastomer, is supple enough for easy cornering. But unlike the coiled spring pivots found on other trailers, it's rigid enough to prevent the trailer from fishtailing during out-of-the-saddle climbs.

Inside the trailer, waterbottle pockets help ensure passengers won't go thirsty. Foam-backed, forward-facing seats provide a reassuring, if less than flattering, view of Mom or Dad, and multi-point safety belts discourage fledgling daredevils from abandoning ship while under way.

Stowaway Rain Canopy (A304)

Carried easily in the Stowaway's rear storage compartment, the vented rain canopy goes on and off the trailer in seconds to protect passengers from a sudden shower. 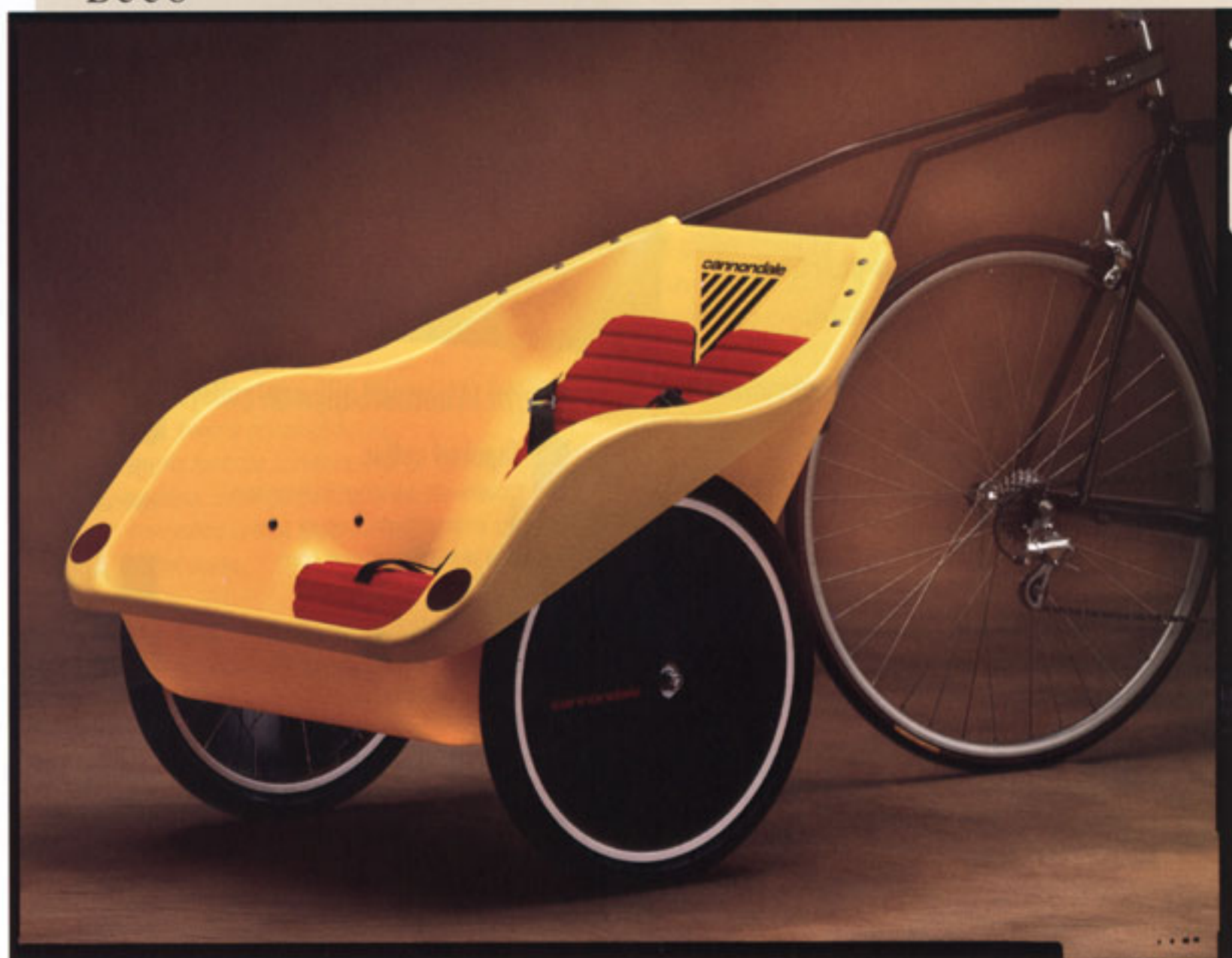

Cycling bags have never been an "add-on" or an afterthought to our bicycle line. We'd been designing and manufacturing innovative bags for a decade before introducing our first bicycle, and our commitment to producing the finest possible cycling accessories has never diminished.

Every Cannondale bag is crafted from durable, waterproof 500 denier nylon Cordura.[®] Experience has taught us that larger fibers make a tight, waterproof weave difficult to achieve. Fabrics with thinner fibers have disappointed us with their inability to withstand abrasion and other abuse.

All of our bags are sewn with eight stitches per inch; a seemingly trivial detail perhaps, but we've found fewer stitches create a weak seam and more stitches weaken the fabric with needle holes. We've even given substantial thought to the thread used to sew our bags together, opting for a cotton-wrapped poly-core thread that swells when wet to help prevent rain penetration at needle holes.

We offer three general categories of bike-mounted bags:¹ Mountain bike bags, lightweight, moderate-capacity road bike bags, and large-capacity/touring bags. And while they're designed with specific end-users in mind, most bags are versatile enough to go from mountain bike to road bike and back without a problem.

CODA Magic Crankset

The revolutionary CODA Magic crankset is up to 200 grams lighter, three times stiffer, and far more flex-resistant than the next lightest parts. The crankset features hollow, elliptical arms that are amazingly rigid despite their feathery weight. Throughout the length of each arm, the wall thicknesses vary to suit the loads and stresses at any given point on the arm. Joining crankarms to chainrings are lightweight spider arms milled to an I beam-like construction that minimizes weight while maximizing stiffness.

Attached to the spider are chainrings that are milled – not punched – from aluminum. (Virtually all other manufacturers punch their chainrings from sheets of aluminum, fracturing and pulverizing the metal along the shear line. Structurally, this damaged metal is useless, serving only as a breeding ground for cracks that spread into the good metal and cause the teeth to wear.)

Each tooth on a CODA Magic chainring is individually milled for long life and to mate perfectly with the chain. What's more, the teeth on a 53-tooth chainring are minutely different from the teeth on a 52 (as are the teeth on a 28 and a 29, etc.). These "generated" teeth are precisely calculated to grab,

hold and release the chain with the greatest possible degree of efficiency.

Each CODA Magic crankset features a brilliant anodized finish and durable milled (not tapped) threads. Note: CODA Magic cranksets must be used with the CODA Magic bottom bracket.

CODA Magic Bottom Bracket

The CODA Magic bottom bracket places its cartridge bearings outboard of the shell in aluminum cups that thread into the bottom bracket shell. (The cups swell in diameter just past the threaded portion to accommodate the oversized bearings.)

Shifting the bearings outboard virtually eliminates spindle flex by reducing the length of unsupported spindle at each end. Moving the bearings also allows the use of a dramatically oversized, hollow aluminum spindle that's both extremely flex-resistant and far lighter than conventional spindles.

The bottom bracket spindle features an eight-lobe taper that utilizes more surface area than the typical four-sided taper for a stronger, more secure connection with the crankarms. Attaching the crankarms to the spindle is a "one-key release" system that makes crankarm installation and removal all but effortless. To protect the bearings, the inboard surface of each crankarm is recessed where it attaches with the spindle. This recessed area physically surrounds the bearing cups to protect them from grit and grime. Available with English or Italian threads, and for 68, 70 and 73 mm bottom bracket shell widths.

- Ride on open trails only
- Leave no trace
- Control your bicycle
- Always yield the trail
- Never spook animals
- Plan ahead

A NOTE ON BICYCLE SAFETY...

You can easily reduce the risk of accident and injury while riding by taking a few simple precautions. We strongly encourage you to take these basic steps:

- Always wear a helmet when riding.
- Keep your speed under control.
- Learn and obey all traffic laws that apply to bicycling.
- Check to insure the quick release skewers on your wheels are properly closed before each ride.
- Test your brakes for proper operation before each ride.
- Make sure your bicycle is equipped with a full complement of reflectors. (Every Cannondale bicycle is shipped with those reflectors required by the Consumer Product Safety Commission. If your Cannondale bicycle does not come with reflectors, please contact your retailer or call us toll-free at 1-800-BIKE-USA. In Pennsylvania, dial 1-814-623-2626.)
- Have all repair and maintenance work performed on your bicycle by an authorized Cannondale retailer.
- We strongly recommend that you familiarize yourself with the basic operation of all the parts on your bicycle. To learn more about cycling safety and bicycle operation, check your library for bicycling books or contact your local bike shop or police department about bicycle safety classes.
